We continue to research the donated books from earlier this year and send some to our online vendor, Book Forest to sell. We continue the two book carts at Duncans Mills and Cazadero General Stores so both of these things bring in some funds.

We are looking into securing a rural grant to electrify our sorting shed, which we hope to accomplish in the next couple or months.

Sonoma County Library is no longer covering insurance for Friends' volunteers so we are in the process of getting insurance for our organization.



SPOTLIGHT ON: CURBSIDE PICKUP


Curbside pickup at Sonoma County Library is available at all locations. Please check the locations page for open hours and contact information at <u>https://sonomalibrary.org/locations</u>.

You can request items through the catalog or phone the library to make a request. You may place up to 50 requests through the online catalog. Once your request has been made, you will receive a text, email, phone or mail notification when your item is ready for pickup. Items will be held for you for 10 days.

Then just visit the library during curbside pickup hours. Call the library and give your first and last names and library card number. Your items will be placed in a paper bag in the curbside pickup area. Please allow staff to leave your items and return to the library before you pick them up. Enjoy!

Returns are accepted Fridays and Saturdays only from 10 am to 5 pm or until the book drop is full.

RIVER FRIENDS BOARD REPORTS

Treasurer's Report

Report for the period May 1 — December 2, 2020: Our biggest source of income has been from Book Forest, our online vendor, for \$1,421.15. Member dues brought in \$615.00 and our Book Carts yielded \$458.04.

Our biggest expense was \$2,000.00 to PG&E to begin the process of electrifying our shed at the County Yard. Our website hosting and service fees was our next-largest expense at \$1,5491.53, which will run for three years at a lower-cost overall. Our support of the LGBT Pride Book Club was a carry-over from last FY and amounted to \$939.10. Our current balance is \$44,182.84.

Membership Report

108 members renewed in 2020. We also have 43 lifetime members. There was a recent mailing to 49 members who have not yet renewed. We show 205 total members in our database with some possibly invalid addresses.
