# **Gym Policies & Procedures**

### Dream Team Elite Cheer Company is committed to following the safety protocol of our athletes.

- Any athlete with a fever over 100.4 or is displaying symptoms will not be allowed to enter the facility. Athletes may re-enter when free of symptoms and fever for 48 hours.
- Dream Team Elite Cheer Company, LLC is not responsible for any theft of damage to personal property of items brought into the facility.
- Privacy is important to Dream Team Elite. Recording videos of team practices, and or competition routine is prohibited.
- Only Dream Team Elite staff and athletes are allowed to enter the gym. Parents are not allowed to enter the cheer floor for any reason unless permitted by a Dream Team Elite Cheer Staff.
- No Food and/or Drinks are allowed on the cheer floor. All food and/or drinks must remain in the gym lobby.

### **Discipline Policy**

Dream Team Elite Cheer company has zero tolerance for the following behaviors including but not limited to those listed below. DTE will enforce a strict discipline policy that could result in immediate removal of the athlete.

- Bullying
- Use of profanity
- Physical altercation
- Vandalism of Gym property or equipment
- Verbal altercation (at administrative staff discretion)
- Dishonesty

#### Disciplinary actions can also include:

- Sitting out in an upcoming performance/ competition
- Penalties that include additional conditioning
- In house gym Chores
- In severe cases, removal from the program

# **Fee Policy**

We understand life happens and as a result, our athletes might have to cancel their membership and participation with DTE. We have implemented the below process to ensure an easy and effective cancellation process.

- \* 30- day notice- please submit a 30-day written notice to dreamteamelitecheer@gmail.com requesting cancellation before the 6th of the month to avoid being charged for next month's tuition. Be sure to include the effective date, and the last day the athlete will be in attendance.
- \* Final monthly tuition payment will be required to cancel in good standings with DTE.
- \* There will be no refunds or repayment for cancellations.
- \* Any account with a pending balance due after the 7th day of each month will be charged a late fee of \$25.00. The account will need to be up to date before the next 30-day payment cycle. Failure to update account within will result in a 30 cycle will result in a suspension period for the associated athlete(s).
- \* Credit Card on file must be up to date and has not expired. Any credit card or ACH payment that is declined will incur a \$10.00 re-processing fee and late fees if unresolved by the 7th day of the payment cycle.
- \* Dream Team Elite Cheer does NOT process refunds of any kind to accounts.
- \* If an athlete is removed or drops (exclusions apply-at the discretion of the board) the Dream Team Elite Program for any reason, you are still financially obligated to pay the monthly fee from July 2023 through April 2024.

# **Competition Information**

Competition season will begin December through April. Competition season can be extended for "invite only" events.

DTE Cheer will attend a minimum of 4 competitions.

Please note most competitions are one-two day events so please try and keep these days totally free. Staying for awards will be expected of everyone!

Should DTE receive a bid to nationals, additional fees may occur.

### **Competition Policy:**

- 1. When arriving day of competion, every athlete must be in full uniform dressed Bow to Toe.
- 2. All athletes must attend the team's specific awards during the competition. Athletes must be dressed competition ready; no backpacks or cell phones are allowed on the award floor.
- 3. During the competition, athletes are to remain in the care of coaches and or DTE designated squad team mom.

Please do not remove your athlete during the competition at any time without notifying via Band App and in person. This includes visiting the concession stands or vendor booth.

- 4. DTE athletes and DTE Families are strongly encouraged to display great sportsmanship win or lose. This includes respect for team members, other teams, parents, and or coaches.
- 5. Black out dates begin 5 days leading up to the competition. All athletes are expected to attend practices during the black out period

#### Camps

All-star athletes are required to attend the two-day DTE choreography camp. This included a unique routine to music that includes stunts, tumbling, jumps, and other talents. Athletes will also have a chance to learn the traditional Stunt, Dance, and Jump curriculum.

Total cost for this camp is \$175.



# **Skill Level Criteria**

### **ATHLETE PLACEMENT**

Athletes are divided into teams based on two factors: age and skill level. Please see the level requirements below.

#### **SKILL LEVEL BREAKDOWN:**

Athletes are evaluated based on their execution of tumbling, jumps and stunts. All skills are significant and will be taken into consideration when putting together successful teams.

All skills must be maintained to remain on any given level/team. DTE reserves the right to move an athlete from one team to another at any point in the season (up OR down) based on performance, ability, necessity or for any other reason.

### **Dream Team Elite Cheer Attendance Policy**

Cheerleading is a team sport which requires every cheerleader to know their responsibilities and perform as part of a TEAM. We are unlike any other sport in that we do not have substitute members if someone is absent. Attendance is essential to the success of each season. Attendance will be taken at the beginning at each practice. Each Cheerleader's 100% commitment is required as each position on the squad is dependent on the other. When one Cheerleader is absent, it places hardship on the entire squad and can become a **safety issue**. It is for these reasons the Cheerleader and the parents must be advised of the importance of compliance to the attendance policy. We understand things may come up throughout the season. For that reason, we have defined our attendance policy below.

### Attendance Policy is as follows

- 1. All practices and competitions are MANDATORY.
- 2. Athletes are expected to be on time (on time is at least 5 minutes early to practice dressed and ready to begin on time!) so they may participate in stretching, warm up, etc....
- 3. Athletes must turn in an Absence Request Form (ARF) at least a week in advance of the requested date to be considered as an excused absence.
- 4. Any missed practices will only be excused if a family emergency occurs, or a special circumstance, as these are crucial to getting ready for competition.
- 5. Athletes cannot miss any practices during the blackout period leading up to competition, **no exceptions.**

Head Coaches and the cheer committee will make final decisions on each absence status. Excessive absences/tardies will be taken into consideration in competition choreography.

# **Examples of excused absences:**

- · Athlete is sick but returns with a doctor's note
- Serious illness or death in the family
- Mandatory school event
- Planned vacation prior to September 1, provided the coach has been notified.

When an athlete or parent knows that he/she is going to be absent or late, he/she has the responsibility to notify their coach in advance via Band App, otherwise it will be treated as an unexcused absence. Also, Coaches understand that occasional school conflicts arise, and we prioritize academics first. However, we also expect cheerleaders to use good time management skills to complete schoolwork and practice.

#### **Examples of unexcused absences:**

- · No notification of absence
- Conflict with other sport/activities (special circumstances apply to sports known ahead of time)
- Non-Life-threatening illness
- Lack of transportation



Dream Team Elite Cheer is expected to be a priority commitment during the season. When a team is missing cheerleaders, it diminishes the cheerleaders' opportunity, both individually and as a group, to safely learn and practice their skills. A single miss affects the entire squad and impacts those cheerleaders who have committed to be at all practices.

After three excused absences, the fourth absence will result in an automatic unexcused absence.

**TARDINESS/LEAVING EARLY**: 3 times unexcused tardy, leaving early, and any combination of the two is considered 1 UNEXCUSED absence.

#### **Consequences for Unexcused Absences**

1<sup>st</sup> unexcused absence: A warning is issued to the athlete and parent.

**2<sup>nd</sup> unexcused absence**: Extra reps of a physical conditioning exercise (cheer jacks, squats, push-ups etc.) or an extra lap of running at the end of practice to make up for what was missed. Ageappropriate activity will be determined by her head coach.

**3rd unexcused absence:** Removal from one competition.

#### Excessive Absences:

If the amount of excused and unexcused absences exceeds 10, this results in the removal of the athlete.

Parents WILL NOT be reimbursed any fees, or tuition of any amount.

By joining DTE I am agreeing to uphold the following team rules:

- 1. I will demonstrate the character quality of attentiveness by listening to the instruction of my coaches.
- 2. I will demonstrate the character quality of commitment by attending all practices and competitions, and on time.
- 3. I will demonstrate the character quality of orderliness by following the dress code:
- A clean-cut appearance is required for the season (i.e. no odd piercings, no radical hair styles or colors, no facial hair).
- I will wear the required uniform for all practices and competitions.
- 4. I will maintain a positive, teachable attitude no matter how fair I perceive the officiating to be or whether we win or lose.
- 5. I will demonstrate the character quality of self-control by not participating in profane language, or any physical violence.
- 6. I will demonstrate the character quality of discipline by following the rules that my coaches establish.
- 7. I will approach my coach with any questions or concerns before/after practice or during breaks.
- 8. I will promote sportsmanship through my words and actions; striving to never speak poorly of our fellow teammates or criticize the coaches.
- 9. I understand that the coaches reserve the right to establish or abolish any team rules.
- 10. I will not particapate any organized team group chat outside of the assigned Band App for my team.
- 11. I have received and read the DTE Handbook.
- 12. I agree to adhere to the Disciplinary Plan as defined in this Code of Conduct, and failure to comply with the disciplinary plan as defined in the document and as prescribed by the head coach will be considered another infraction in the same category.
