Miami, March 6th .- Enjoy great Peruvian movies, Peruvian food and entertainment and meet the filmmakers. The 3rd edition of **Filmed in Peru** that kicks off on Thursday 10th at the Silverspot Cinema in Miami Downtown as part of the Peruvian Night of the 42nd Miami Film Festival.

These two films have either never been shown in the USA or have had limited screenings. And they are all subtitled in English.

Reinas - A co-production between Peru and Switzerland, which was the Swiss entry for the 2025 Oscars. Actor Gustavo Molina will be at screening for an introduction and Q&A session.

Mistura - with Barbara Mori and Christian Meyer. A film that is so new it hasn't even been shown in Peru yet. It's about a Franco-Peruvian woman who falls in love with the gastronomic and cultural diversity of Peru. Director Ricardo de Montreuil will be attending the screening.
