

## RED CARPET GUESTS ANNOUNCED FOR "FILMED IN PERU"

Miami, March 18th.- Actors, producers and film directors will walk the red carpet for the 3rd edition of the Peruvian film showcase **Filmed in Peru** (April 10-18 in Miami, Long Island & New York City). Ricardo de Montreuil, director of "Mistura" (with Barbara Mori and Christian Meier), actor Gonzalo Molina, the star of "Queens," actress and supermodel Juana Burga and 12 others have confirmed their attendance. "The presence of Peruvian filmmakers and actors has always been an important part of our showcase," said Director Robert Pazos. "And this year we are bringing a record number of guests to our screenings in Miami, Long Island and New York City."

"Filmed in Peru" features 20 films, all shot in Peru, including 12 feature-length fiction and documentaries and eight short films. A free filmmakers panel will feature Stephanie Boyd ("Karuara"), Leonardo Barbuy ("Diogenes") and other filmmakers. "It's an opportunity to showcase the best of our cinematography to the world," says Carlos Bañuelos, actor/director of the short film "That's What Friends Are For."

- Comedy Lovers: Laugh out loud with "The Last Laugh", " a comedy about an aging comedian's struggles.

- **True Crime Fans**: Witness the gripping "The Gringa & the Musician," exposing police corruption in Peru.
- Based on a True Story: <u>"The Inheritance of Flora"</u> a narrative drama based on the life of feminist Flora Tristán and <u>"Tattoos in the Memory"</u> based on true events during Peru's struggles with the Shining Path terrorists.
