About Our Site

Osborn Farm is a working farm that uses its fields for raising cattle. Fields are mostly open although some are surrounded by barbed wire fences and include ground-cover native to the area that occasionally is mowed. Most of the fields are mowed hay fields.

Awards

Each dog that passes will receive a glove embroidered with the club's initials.

Notes to Exhibitors

Eligibility. This test will be for dogs not less than six (6) months of age that are eligible for entry. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the titles TD, TDU, TDX or VST. Dogs not holding any tracking dog title will be given priority for entry in the test by the tracking test secretary.

With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC TD or TDU test, there must be filed an original statement, dated within one year of the date of the test to be held, signed by a person who has been approved by the AKC to judge tracking tests, certifying that the dog is considered by him/her ready for such test.

Bitches in season may participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8, of the Tracking Regulations.

Notes to Exhibitors and Spectators

The Test Chairman's cell phone is available the day of the test for emergency contact: (706) 207-2192.

- Tracking test hours: 6:30 a.m. 6:00 p.m.
- Park only in designated areas.
- Pick up after yourselves and your dogs.
- Bring your own shade, chairs, and water.
- Dogs are not allowed off lead during test hours.
- Any complaints from motels regarding exhibitors may result in a bench show committee hearing.
- All persons on the property used for the test must sign a waiver of liability. This form will be available at the draw.
- No smoking on the testing grounds.
- Chapter 1, Section 17 of the Tracking Regulations: "Dogs Running Free. Due to the changing nature of the fields being used
 by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs must be "on lead" at all times
 on any area of the tracking site."

Directions to Draw Site

From I-85 take the Hwy 441 South exit towards Commerce, GA (Exit # 149). Continue on 441 until the Athens Loop, GA Rt. 10 (approximately 20 miles). Turn right onto the ramp. Exit onto US 78 West/US 29 South/GA 316 West (approximately 6 miles from Hwy 441). Keep right at the ramp. Turn left at the next light onto the Oconee Connector. The Oconee Connector becomes Mars Hill Road which then becomes Experiment Station Road. McDonald's will on the right after the traffic light at GA 53.

From Rt. 316 turn right onto Hwy 53/Hog Mountain Road. Cross over Hwy 78 and at the next light turn right onto Experiment Station Road. McDonald's will be immediately on the Right.

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC-approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

- [1] (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- [2] The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- [3] (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- [4] A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
