From the Pastor . . .

I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought. (1 Corinthians 1:10)

UNITY. This word "unity" is one we've heard a lot lately. We've heard it from political parties, we've heard it from public health officials in the midst of the current pandemic, and we've heard it from church leaders as the United Methodist Church seems to be on a collision course with separation. Unfortunately, in every instance, these calls for "unity" are coy ways of saying, "You people need to listen to ME!" The call is not for a coming together under a common goal; it is about one idea, one plan, one theology being right and every other one being wrong.

As we read Paul's words to the church in Corinth, you may be thinking that this is another example of the Bible asking us to do something that we as humans, as citizens, or as Christians are simply incapable. However, Paul is the practical one. Chosen by the risen Christ himself, Paul takes the gospel and the teachings of Jesus and puts it all into a no-nonsense, practical way for us. In this case, Paul is writing to the church because their unity is challenged by people lining up behind different leaders. Just like today, different leaders have different ways—different ideas—for reaching the same goal. But, human pride and human stubbornness gets in the way. "This is the way we've always done it" vs. "This is a new way of doing (the same thing)," is generally how we experience it in the church. But the stakes are much higher than carpet color, method of receiving Communion, or whether or not we like the hymns projected onto a screen.

At Corinth, the church was being torn apart because some followed Paul and others wanted to follow a local leader named Apollos. Because of this division, the church could not focus on the important stuff. In the case of Corinth, a church member having an affair with his stepmother. A relationship that Paul makes clear falls under Jesus' teaching of sexual immorality. But, as I said, the church cannot lovingly and properly address this situation because of their preoccupation of division. When Paul says, "in the name of Jesus Christ . . . let there be no divisions among you," he's not using Jesus' name as a tag line or expression of exasperation (like many of us heard from well meaning parents or bosses). Paul is being quite literal. He means be unified in Christ! And if we are unified in Christ—in His teachings and gospel—we can follow different leaders and we can come together in unity. At the same time, if we are unified in Christ-His teachings and gospel—we understand and are unified in what is not righteous, what is sinful. But we can now handle it through, what John Wesley called, "accountability in love" — with compassion, empathy, and mercy.

Unfortunately, the calls to unity we are hearing today are not! And if we line up with leaders who are not unified in Christ, we are not unified in Christ and we are not living the life God wills for us.

**Social Media & Heritage UMC.** Some quick statistics on how our social media efforts are playing out. Face Book is our main social media presence, but we also have our videos available on You Tube. We are averaging about 1 post on FB per day. This includes Sunday and Wednesday worship services and the Wednesday devotional: "In the Word Wednesday with Pastor Ron." The metric we are using is what FB calls "People Reached" — this number indicates how many people saw our post. Since November 1<sup>st</sup> (thru

December 21<sup>st</sup>) we are averaging 183 people reached per post. For our 2 worship services, Sunday & Wednesday, we are averaging 315 people reached each week. "In the Word Wednesday with Pastor Ron" has averaged 129 people reached each week. Our You Tube audience is growing as we have upwards of 40 views per video. These numbers mean that Heritage UMC is connecting people to Jesus Christ beyond our own church members; and that is what the Great Commission is all about.
