Winter Safety



As the weather gets colder we want to remind everyone that our parking lot is a no idle zone. Please turn your car off when you come inside to drop off or pick up your child. This is for yours and the children's safety. Also, please do not leave young children unattended in a vehicle when you come into the center. Thank you for your help in keeping everyone safe.

Monthly Reminders:

- Please make sure to call the office by 9am if you are running late or will be absent. Or use the ProCare app to message us!
- Peppermint Patty's dress code requires that all children were close toed shoes. Also, shorts are required under dresses and skirts.
- Peppermint Patty's will be CLOSED on Thursday December 25th & Friday December 26th. We are also CLOSED Thursday January 1st and Friday January 2nd.
- Please make sure that your child has 2 changes of seasonably appropriate extra clothing in their backpack.

Cold Weather Attire

Just a reminder that every child needs to come to school with a warm coat, hat, and gloves. If your child comes to school without these items, we may ask you to go home and bring them back. We WILL go outside most days depending on the weather. There is not a specific temperature that is a cut off but we also take into consideration wind speeds and whether it is sunny or cloudy. We will also use our licensing issued wind chill chart to make our determination. Finally, please be sure to label their outer gear.

Christmas Parties

We will be having our Christmas Parties on Friday December 19th. Please watch your Procare messages for a Sign Up Genius link to sign up for needed items to help our parties be a success. We will also be doing a book exchange during our parties. Please bring a wrapped age appropriate book for your child to exchange. Each gift will be numbered and the kids will take turns drawing numbers to see which book will be theirs to take home. This has been a highlight of our parties in years past and I am sure it will continue to be great fun this year!
