Dress Code & Backpack Policies

We want to take this opportunity to remind all of our families of our dress code policies here at Peppermint Patty's. Our days are full of fun and mess and we want everyone to be as comfortable as possible.

* Cowboy boots are not allowed. They do not provide enough traction when running on the playground.

* Closed toed shoes are required. As the weather gets warmer, we want to keep little toes safe while playing, so that is why they must be covered.

* Tie Shoes are not allowed. We strive to promote independence and tie shoes do not allow for that.

* Shorts or leggings are required under dresses and skirts.

* Dress appropriately for the weather. We get outside as much as possible so please make sure your child has on the appropriate clothes and outerwear.

* Play clothes are a must. While we try to keep your child as clean as possible there will be times in our fun where they may get messy. We don't want to ruin any nice clothes.

Just a reminder that all children at the center are required to bring a backpack. This is a backpack that

should be used only for school and nothing else. Each child's backpack should be stocked with at least 2 changes of clothes and more if your child is potty training. Please do not put wipes or any kind of medication in your child's backpack. Any medication that needs to come to school needs to be handed to Ms. Audra or Ms. Liz so it can be locked up and a medication form needs to be filled out. Finally, make sure you are taking your child's backpack home daily so that it can be restocked if needed. We reserve the right to turn away any child that comes without a stocked backpack in the mornings.
