Wednesday May 20th:

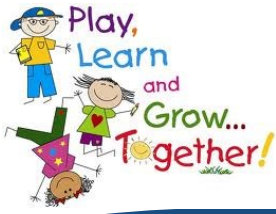
"Workout Wednesday"- Wear your workout gear and we will have some fitness fun.
