Thank You to Our Gabbaim

Dear Friends,

Thanksgiving, as in giving thanks, is a very Jewish thing to do. According to tradition, Jews are to give thanks 100 times each day. We are to give thanks before we eat, for having food, and after we eat, for having been able to have food.

I love Thanksgiving for the reminders that come from the very name itself – the invitation to give thanks for what we have, how we live, the food we eat, and the freedom we live.

This month in honor of Thanksgiving I want to give thanks to one group of people that attend all services and do exceptional jobs- our *Gabbaim*.

First some explanation from My Jewish Learning about the meaning of the term Gabbaim:

"Gabbai (pl. gabbaim) is an Aramaic word that means tax collector, but today a gabbai is someone who assists with the reading of the Torah. Typically, when the Torah is taken out to be read before the community, one person reads the Torah, and that person is surrounded on either side with two gabbaim who ensure that the Torah is being read and treated respectfully and accurately. One of the gabbaim also assigns aliyot (plural of aliyah, being called up to the Torah) to the members of the congregation, and calls up the people who are being honored with aliyot. In many communities the gabbai is charged with making sure that all synagogue services run smoothly, a logistical job that can be a lot of work. In other communities, the gabbai collects money for the synagogue. It is considered an honor and a great responsibility to be the gabbai, or one of the gabbaim, in any community."

Our *Gabbaim* truly deserve to be honored and acknowledged for their contribution to our Temple. I am delighted to have the opportunity to pay tribute and to honor my dear friends and assistants, the *Gabbaim*:

Danny Winkler, Lenny Reznik, Mark Sloan, Anne Peacock, Heather Concklin and Roz & Alvin Weinerman.

From our long history, we know that, since the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem in 70 CE, the synagogue attained a central role as a unifying institution for the Jewish community.

In my view, a synagogue has many functions, but in its core, it is a house of prayers, and here comes into play the important role of our *Gabbaim*. In Temple Emanu-El we are blessed with a group of dedicated individuals who attend all Shabbat and holiday services and help to lead, orchestrate, organize and chant prayers. The *Gabbaim* add to the splendor and glory of the ritual that our tradition is so known for. Each one of them brings a rich experience and a special flavor combined with his/her expertise. Their weekly commitment enhances our services; however, more than knowledge, they bring their love and devotion to Judaism. Their devotion reflects on their true service of the heart. Temple Emanu-El is indebted to their magnificent activities, and their efforts are praised in the eyes of man and in the eyes of God.

May you continue your Mitzvot Journey, and may you be privileged to do many more good deeds. May God bless you and your loved ones with a good life, health, and prosperity.






