

## Who is Truly Rich?

Dear Friends,

Our Hanukkah dinner was a great success, and the Brothers of Temple Emanu-El have proved again that they can cook a sumptuous meal. The children's talent show was a great hit, and I enjoyed seeing all of you marvel as the excellent young performers from our temple sang, danced, and played their chosen instruments. One day, a wealthy father took his son on a trip to the country to show him what it was like to be poor. They stayed for a few days and nights on a farm where a destitute family lived.

After they returned home, the father asked his son how he liked the trip. "It was great, Dad," the son replied. "Did you see how poor people can be?" the father asked. "Oh yeah," the son answered.

"So what did you learn from the trip?" asked the father. The son thought for a moment and said, "I saw that we have one dog and they have four. We have a pool that runs halfway across our garden, and they have a creek that never ends. We have fancy lanterns in our garden, and they have stars that twinkle at night. Our patio is large and extends to the front yard, but they have the entire horizon.

We have a small piece of land, but they have fields that extend as far as the eye can see. We have servants who work for us, but they serve others. We buy our food, but they grow their own. We have walls around our property to keep us safe, but they have friends to protect

them.” The father was silent; then the son added, “It showed me just how poor we really are.”

We often forget how much we have and fixate on what we don’t. What one person considers worthless, another might treasure. It all depends on how you see things.

Sometimes, it takes a child's perspective to remind us of what really matters.

May the New Year 2026 be a year when we set our priorities right. When we are grateful for whatever Hashem has given us and are content with our lot.

May the New Year 2026 usher in an era of peace. Peace in our homes, peace in our schools, peace in Israel, and peace for the entire world, Amen.


