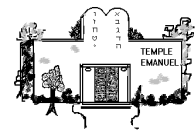

Is This Your Ten Million Dollars?

Dear Friends,

This year's Passover Seder at the Dunes Club was truly special. More than 120 congregants and guests gathered to celebrate together, enjoying a delicious kosher-for-Passover meal and wonderful desserts. The breathtaking ocean view and the warm, festive atmosphere added a unique sense of beauty and spirituality to the evening. May we continue to share more festive, quality times together.

We live in a fast-paced and often overwhelming world. It seems that one major event follows another, leaving us astonished and, at times, unsettled.

If you follow the news, you see constant “breaking news,” tensions and conflict involving Iran, instability in global markets, rising oil prices, ongoing challenges along Israel's northern border, fragile peace discussions, and the troubling rise of anti-Semitic incidents around the world. It can feel like it's too much to absorb.

And yet, in the midst of all this, we must not lose sight of who we are and what our mission is in this world.

I would like to share a short fictional story from the Chabad website titled **“Is This Your Ten Million Dollars?”** by Aron Moss. While the story itself is imaginary, its message is deeply real.

“A man receives an email informing him that he has won a vast fortune—ten million dollars. All he needs to do is claim it. But instead of celebrating, he politely declines. Why? Because, as he explains, in our tradition, something that is not earned is not truly ours.

“He reflects that we live in a world of effort. What comes easily often disappears just as quickly. True blessing requires a vessel—and that vessel is created through our own effort, commitment, and engagement.

“He continues by saying that he has already inherited something far more valuable: the gift of being a Jew--a legacy of thousands of years of spiritual depth, moral vision, and enduring wisdom. But even that inheritance cannot be taken for granted. It must be lived, nurtured, and made our own, or it, too, can fade.

“He concludes simply: “With my Jewish inheritance, I am already rich.”

This message is especially meaningful for us today.

In a world filled with uncertainty, we are reminded that our true strength does not come from external circumstances, but from within—from our values, our faith, our tradition, and our commitment to live meaningful Jewish lives.

Let us continue to invest in that inheritance, to strengthen our connection to our people and our tradition, and to pass it on proudly to the next generation.

Wishing you all continued blessings, strength, and peace.
