Period**

Turning 65 or qualifying for  
Medicare due to disability -  
you have 7 months to enroll:  
the month of birth (or  
disability) and 3 months prior  
or after.

**Special Election  
Period**

Special situations may allow  
you to enroll in or  
switch plans:

- Check with me to see if you  
qualify.

**Annual Election  
Period**

**OCTOBER 15  
DECEMBER 7**

EVERY YEAR - use your  
Annual Election Period to add,  
drop, switch, or keep (if it is  
still available), your Medicare  
plan.
