Clara Love Elementary PTA offers scholarship(s), as permitted by the approved budget, to graduating Byron Nelson High School, Northwest High School, Eaton High School, or Steele Accelerated High School seniors who will be enrolled in an accredited college or university or a technical/vocational institute in the summer or fall semester immediately following his/her high school graduation. Funds for the scholarships come from Clara Love Elementary PTA's membership fees, fundraising, and community sponsorships.

Purpose of Scholarship

The purpose is to support Byron Nelson High School, Northwest High School, Eaton High School, and Steele Accelerated High School students who are focused on achieving career goals through higher education. In evaluating each application, the scholarship committee will also consider service and participation in school activities, community involvement, and scholastic merit.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicant must meet the following eligibility requirements:
