MEMORIALS

Wellington Manor is in full support of honoring deceased residents of the community with memorials. The Grounds Committee has listed options below for community member guidance in selecting a remembrance.

Please consider one of the following:

- 1. An engraved stone paver memorial could be set at the flagpole plaza.
- 2. An engraved stone paver memorial may be placed close to an existing tree in its surrounding mulch bed.
- 3. A new tree can be purchased and an engraved stone paver memorial be placed in front of it. The WM Grounds Committee will need to be consulted as to the location and type of any new tree.
- 4. The four cul-de-sac mini gardens (located at the end of Lexington, Buckingham, Westminster and York) could also be selected as a location to place an engraved stone memorial.

*Options 1-4 would be using a $6^{\circ} \times 9^{\circ}$ engraved stone paver to match the existing pavers set at the flagpole plaza in front of the clubhouse.

5. There are three existing benches in the RAC area which could be used for placement of metal memorials plaques to be attached to the backrest. The size, color and engraving should be consistent with other metal memorials on benches in that area.

- All expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the donor.
- All plans for memorials must be reviewed with the Grounds Committee prior to any memorials being placed.
