HISTORICAL AND CURRENT INFORMATION

The home page is comprised of six (6) main sections where access to all historical and current information related to the DPRI Enterprise Program can be found.

Navigate to the top of the page and utilize any of the section links to access the content.

- 1. Program Management Guidance** – This page provides access to all the files related to the overall DPRI Program Management, including Historical Reference documents, and International Agreements.
- 2. Oversight Tools** – This page provides access to files associated with enterprise-level risk management functions to include the DPRI Rainbow Chart and change management.
- 3. Meeting/Strat Comm** – This page provides access to historical meeting agendas and minutes across a wide range of stakeholder led and institutional meetings conducted in support of DPRI.
- 4. Policy Issues** – This page provides access to information designed to enable a shared understanding of key enterprise-level high-visibility topics.
- 5. Resource Management** - This page provides access to information and files supporting manpower and financial management responsibilities of DPRI.
- 6. US-DoJ Bilateral** - This page provides information on the quarterly meetings between the U.S. DoD and GoJ MOD in support of DPRI and many other supporting files.

GLOBAL DOCUMENT SEARCH

From one location, the user is able to search across the entire set of almost 600, and growing, pieces of content/files contained within the various document libraries in EPIC.

Type in the search terms you wish to search on into the search box and the system will automatically reduce the options for you.

STAKEHOLDER DASHBOARD

The forthcoming Stakeholder Dashboard will have content geared towards the end user based on the organization they support and the role they provide. Widgets developed and pending release include: Programmatic Activities in support of MCO objectives; Risk Register; Issue Log; Request For Information (RFI); Action Tracker; and Meetings Management.
