

The Pacific Branch (PL(P)) Command Library is a centralized location for all historical and current artifacts utilized in support of the Defense Policy Review Initiative (DPRI).

All historical documents from the share drive, laptops, and legacy SharePoint sites are collected, aligned with PL(P) capabilities, and assigned appropriate metadata to assist with search and e-discovery.

In accordance with all records management policy requirements, all content is designated as either a reference copy (non-record) or PL(P)-generated record.

As a centralized repository, the PL(P) Command Library supports current operations, Knowledge Management, and Records Management.

#### **KEY FACTS**



- The entire command library is one SharePoint site utilizing pages for ease of development, management, and control.
- There are no folders utilized in the command library and the utilization of metadata allows for searchability, moveability, and modifications with ease.



Each capability section has two user guides: one for how to add, edit or delete content using SharePoint functionality, and a custom governance document explaining the unique metadata requirements for the associated capability.

## FEATURES OF THE COMMAND LIBRARY



The library has a comprehensive search capability that searches the over 3,800 items and growing daily, across 7 different document libraries, by title and by description.

### **LEADERSHIP NOTIFICATION:**




All content can be identified to leadership via a preset notification. This feature not only helps distinguish important documents/records from the rest of the library's content but also appears in a separate search box on the PL(P) leadership page. No need to email, just ask staff to flag it for leadership notification.

Utilizing a single list and multiple views, each major functional area (Financial Management, Knowledge Management, IMP, and SharePoint) enter and update their POAM within their pages and a consolidated Branch wide POAM is available for leadership.
