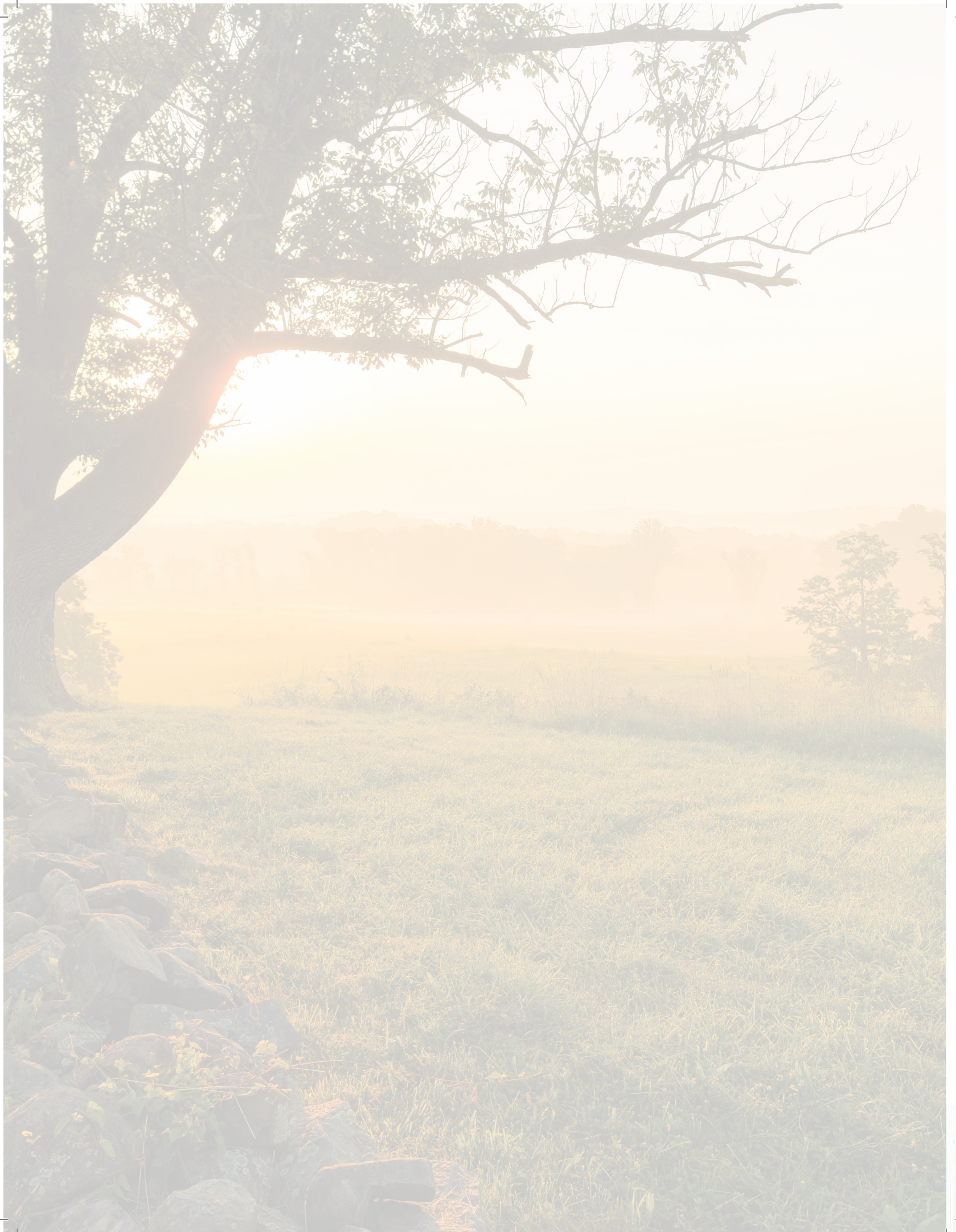

ACCESS

Check-In time is 4:00 PM.

Please use the entrance with the two white piers at the end of the driveway. The piers are labeled "Ricker Angus Ranch Guest" and "6658". You will use the door with the electronic access box. The code is provided by your host. To enter the home, press the code and the door will unlock. To lock the home when leaving, press the lock button on the bottom right.

HOT TUB

The hot tub cover is equipped with a cover opener for ease of use. When closing the cover, please note that there is a **red knob located on the right side of the opener that must be depressed in order for the mechanism to close properly.**

After use, please return the cover to the closed position to help maintain water temperature and cleanliness.

POOL

Our pool is heated and maintained at 86° F for your comfort and enjoyment.

Please do not adjust the pool heater or operate any pool equipment. The settings have been carefully calibrated to provide the best experience while protecting the equipment. If you would prefer the pool temperature adjusted, please contact your host and we will be happy to assist.

HOT TUB AND POOL SAFETY

For everyone's safety and to keep the area clean, we kindly ask that no food, drinks, or glassware be brought into the pool or hot tub. Additionally, glassware is not permitted anywhere around the pool or hot tub.

Do not leave children unattended.

FIRE PIT

The fire pit is near the beginning of the walking path. We are happy to provide firewood for your outdoor fire so you can enjoy a cozy evening outdoors. A reasonable amount of wood will be supplied to get you started. If more firewood is required:

HIKING PATH

Enjoy a peaceful hike along our on-site path, lined with natural wood chips and surrounded by the beauty of the countryside. Follow the green markings on the posts and trees that will lead you to Beaver Creek- perfect for relaxing, exploring, or taking in the scenery. Please note: the path runs alongside an electric fence used for farm purposes. For your safety, do not touch the fence and always supervise children.

Run of the Land

ELECTRIC FENCE

We are happy to share our farm with you, but for everyone's safety, please avoid touching the electric fence and do not approach or feed the cows.

CATTLE

Our cattle aren't confined to one spot. They roam the land naturally. On hot days, they often wander into the woods for shade or move to different pastures to graze. Please be patient if you don't see them immediately. They are usually nearby!

TESLA CHARGING STATION

Complimentary Tesla charging is available during your stay. The charger is located at the bottom garage door and may be used by guests with compatible electric vehicles.

HOME ETIQUETTE

Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted inside the home. Failure to follow this guideline will result in a fine. Please smoke and/or vape in the designated areas outside.

Parties and other social functions/gatherings are strictly prohibited.

Guests are to keep noise at a minimum between 10:00 pm and 8:00 am.

Please put all trash and recyclables in bags. Trash can be thrown in the green bins and recyclables in the blue bins that are located outside of the home.
