

PURPLE LIGHTS (2004–2025)

On November 7, 2024, an unseasonably warm autumn day, Gary Lynn Olson said goodbye to her remarkable cow horse mare, PURPLE LIGHTS. PURPLE LIGHTS, a 2004 bay mare by SMART LITTLE PISTOL and out of OAK N STARLIGHT by GRAYS STARLIGHT, was bred by Ronald Kuntson of Spokane, WA. In 2013, Gary Lynn and PURPLE LIGHTS were Reserve World Champions in working cow horse at the Adequan Select World Championship Show. Three years later in 2016, they took the World Championship title. PURPLE LIGHTS had a lifetime earnings of \$16,303.

GARY LYNN OLSON is a lifetime MQHA member and an AQHA National Director representing Montana. Gary Lynn has 6 World Championships in the Amateur Select Working Cow Horse and 5 Reserve World Championships, all earned between 2007 - 2017.



The Bill & Sherrie Harrison Memorial Secondary Education Scholarship application is due **August 1, 2026**, for one of the two **\$500** scholarships available.



Ty Erickson & FINDING NEMO

("Crush") earned round 3 steer wrestling honors with 3.5 seconds. Ty, the 2019 World Champion from Helena, tells the story of how Crush got his name, "He's by a sire named FINDING NEMO (by Streakin Rascal/Streakin Dash). The turtle on that movie, his name is "Crush." He's just like "heyyy dude," but when he decides to go downstream, he hauls butt. And that's exactly Crush's personality. He's just kinda laid back until it's time to do his job and then he hauls butt." Crush was the 2024 steer wrestling horse of the year. Ty and Crush won **10th in the average** at 34 seconds/8 head and **8th in the World** with \$246,269.51.



Sam Petersen

from Helena arrived at the WNFR as a first-time qualifier. Ten

nights later, the Helena native left with the **Bareback average title** (854 pts/10 head). Sam ended up **10th in the World** with \$448,754.92.

Wrangler National Finals Rodeo (WNFR), presented by Teton Ridge is widely regarded as the Super Bowl of rodeo, serving as the championship event of the **Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association**. Each December, the top 15 money-winners from the regular season in each major discipline earn their spot in this 10-night showdown. This year **Montana** proudly sent returning champions, seasoned veterans and first-time qualifiers—5 in all—to compete for a total purse of over \$13.5 million.

Haven Meged and SEVEN S

TOMAHAWK ("Smoke") a 2016 gelding by Mr Playinstylish x Seven S Sassy Zan/ Seven S Zanaday won **3rd in the average** (90 seconds/10 calves) and **7th in the World** with \$279,930.10.

Haven notes Smoke's style differs from "Lil Punch" (FOR GOODNESS SHAKES), the longtime standout who isn't in Las Vegas this year due to injury. Haven & Smoke won the 9th go-around, the seventh of his NFR career.



Tayla Moeykens stepped inside the Thomas & Mack for the first time in 2025. The **Three Forks** cowgirl was one of the youngest in the field at age 23.

But for Tayla Moeykens, the adversity began before the opening run. A nationwide outbreak of Equine Herpesvirus (EHV-1) forced her to make a difficult decision: leave her main horses, "Yeti" (KN FAMES BEST YET) and "Lizard" (JM POCKETSDOUBLEDASH), at home for their safety and compete on a borrowed mount instead.

Tayla Moeykens started on "Penny" (**STREAKIN FIREWATER**), whom a friend, barrel racer Cindy Grainger "so graciously lent me... while we're there" and "Winnie" (**SCR CATS MERADA PEP**). But when Tayla needed another horse this week, fellow first-time Wrangler NFR qualifier Katelyn Scott rode to the rescue, offering her back-up horse "Kian" (**HEAVEN SENT FAME**).



Sage Newman from

Melstone was **4th in the Average** (840.25 pts/10 horses and **10th in the World** with \$275,691.26 in winnings.
