



Silver Buckles for Youth, Senior, Open and 10&Under divisions to be awarded at the last show

Highpoint English and Western awarded at each show

To qualify for a buckle, you must nominate yourself prior to your first show and show 3 of the 4 shows. The Classes that count towards buckles are as follows:

10 and under Classes Buckle: 1,2,7,9,14,18,29,34,38

18 & Under (age on Jan 1) Youth: 1,2,4,10,15,19,30,35,39

Senior (19 as of Jan 1) Buckle: 1,2,5,11,16,20,22,24,26,31,36,40

Open Classes Buckle: 1,2,6,8,12,13,17,21,23,25,27,28,32,33,37,41

Ties will be decided by place/participation in showmanship.

To Enter: Email, your completed and signed entry **form must be received before Monday at noon:** <u>westernmontanaquarterhorse@gmail.com</u>. Entries received after Monday do not qualify for the pre-entry discounted rates. Entry at the show is allowed but pre-entry is discounted.

All 10 & under classes are Walk/Trot. All classes judged according to AQHA rules when applicable. Training tack and 2 hands are acceptable if used in a humane manner. Two hands in a shank will not be placed above an equal scoring run made one handed with a shank bit. The Judge's decision is final. Stallions must be handled by adults only. Thank you.



Offering full AQHA & MQHA points at Open show prices

Each year, the last weekend in June, MQHA Amateurs sponsor a Rookie/Level 1 AQHA horse show. The Amateurs wanted to encourage 4-H'ers and open show competitors to try showing their Quarter Horse at the breed level. The feedback from a Facebook inquiry told the amateurs that open show competitors don't enter AQHA shows due to the competition and the price. Therefore, the Amateurs designed this show at open show entry fees so competitors could experience the FUN at a breed show while realizing they ARE competitive showing their Quarter Horses.

Last year, an Amateur and a Youth, each at her FIRST AQHA show, won her respective halter class. They both left with a support group of friends and a promise to return.














AQHA RANCHING HERITAGE BREEDER QUALIFICATIONS

AQHA Ranching Heritage Breeders should embody the longevity, integrity and honesty of the ranching tradition. Ranching Heritage Breeders breed and raise the ranch-type horse, which remains at the core of the American Quarter Horse Association and epitomizes the breed's versatility. To be recognized as a Ranching Heritage Breeder, breeders must meet the following criteria:

- ⇒ The ranch must be a <u>member of the American Quarter Horse</u> <u>Association.</u>
- ⇒ Ranch remudas must consist of registered American Quarter Horses.
- ⇒ The ranch must breed and register at least five foals annually for the past 10 years.
- ⇒ The ranch must maintain a remuda for the specific purpose of operating a working cattle ranch.
- ⇒ The ranch must have received, at minimum, an AQHA 10-year Breeder award.
 - ⇒ Applicants must submit at least three reference letters including at least one from a current Ranching Heritage Breeder.

 ⇒ The ranch must apply to and be approved by the AQHA Ranching Committee and AQHA Executive Committee.
 - ⇒ The ranch must pay a \$25 annual fee to maintain status as a Ranching Heritage Breeder.

LEGISLATIVE

THE HORSE PROTECTIONS ACT

On May 8, 2024, APHIS published a new Horse Protection Final Rule in the Federal Register that takes effect February 1, 2025.

AQHA IS WORKING WITH THE AMERICAN HORSE COUNCIL to minimize any probable negative impacts on the equine industry. The AQHA Show and Animal Welfare Departments are actively monitoring the information regarding the regulations, and are committed to gathering correct information and answers regarding the program. As this new rule will be burdensome to event managers, AQHA is communicating with USDA-APHIS to report approved shows and is also working to identify what information is necessary for post-show reports.
