AQHA writes, "Before, during and after serving as AQHA president, Montana rancher Stan Weaver was fully involved in putting AQHA's

focus back on its ranch roots. Because he had asthma, Stan wanted to become a tax lawyer. But that all changed when his mom got sick and his dad asked him to come

back to the ranch. That's where he built up the ranch's American Quarter Horse herd and became involved with AQHA. He was elected president in March 2019. Stan was involved in the development of the AQHA Ranching Heritage program, which includes Ranching Heritage Breeders, ranch horse competitions and the AQHA Ranching Heritage Young Horse Development Program.










The Horse Show Husband "Personalities In The Pen"

To quote a country singer who was the real deal, "the calving's all done and the branding is through; so there ain't but one thing left to do". LeDoux was, and still is, one of my favorite singers because he talked the talk and walked the walk. Anyone who wins a world bareback title is dam sure a hand.

Anyway, those lyrics got this Horse Show Husband to thinking about the branding season winding down as horse show season hits full stride. The show pen and the branding pen are certainly different arenas but I've observed similarities in the personalities of folks who ride in those pens. So here goes my **Freudian analysis for the HSH edition of "Personalities in the Pen".**

OBSESSIVE OSCAR: To get the ball rolling there is **Obsessive Oscar**. Whether in the branding pen or the show pen everything must be PERFECT for Oscar. He will coil and recoil his rope 100 times to have the size of each coil be precisely equal. He will constantly adjust and readjust his saddle, gloves, glasses, and Stetson until he's satisfied all is ship shape.



In the Show Pen, Oscar is constantly measuring rein length, worrying about the pad to saddle proportion, concerned his horse is lame, and always making sure his clean jeans are spotless.



WILLY NILLY: Now the antithesis of Oscar is Willy Nilly. Old Willy rolls in late to the brandings and the horse shows as he is always a day late and a dollar short. It doesn't occur to him that he missed a belt loop on his britches or that his horse is missing one shoe and about to throw a second. "Ride boldly ride" is Willy's motto and he loses zero sleep about placing at a show or catching a calf as long he has fun. His blood pressure runs a steady 100/65 no matter the hand he's been dealt.

SANDBAGGER SARAH: Next we have **Sandbagger Sara**. Sara is constantly downplaying her ability along with her horse's ability. Then she proceeds to double hock every single calf she tosses her loop at while her horse never misses a beat.



When Sara is in the Show Pen she never misses a lead, her horse is always bridled up pretty as a picture, and she usually places in the top 3 under every single judge. Sara is a humble gal with lots of talent in either pen.

PRETENCIOUS PETE: Humble is not a word used to describe the next Personality of the Pen: **Pretentious Pete**. Pete acts like everyone came to the branding or show just to watch him. He's the type of guy who will tell you exactly what you are doing wrong from his perspective whether you asked for his insight or not. Because he audited an Al Dunning Clinic in the 80's and met Ray Hunt at a book signing; he feels that he's an expert.



He's also the guy who has an excuse for everything when it's not going his way: "the judge doesn't like sorrels", "the other ropers didn't shape that calf up correctly", "I was given the wrong pattern by the secretary", "nobody told me we are expected to catch two feet", and the list goes on. Pete runs a discount store in the city called Excuses "R" Us.

PASSIVE AGGRESSIVE PATTY: Pete's half-sister is **Passive Aggressive Patty**. She always expects to rope alongside the top hands and always brings her horse even when she's NOT invited to the branding. She's attended every roping clinic in the Tri-State area for the past 6 years but still has a figure 8 in her loop from the first one she attended.

At the horse show she just assumes she will win her class Every. Single. Time. After all, she bought the high selling horse at the Breeders Cup Futurity Sale and it was professionally trained for several years before that. There is no way another horse ridden by another horsewoman should ever place above her but when





it does the passive aggressive comments rain cats and dogs. You can usually catch the negativity at the out gate as she leaves the arena, the concessions stand while she's cussing the price of a burger, or in the alley next to the stalls while she watches others work. Never mind that there are lots of good hands out there on lots of good horses working hard to improve. Patty just assumes that since she won somewhere that she is gonna win everywhere. Patty needs to learn that hard work beats talent when talent doesn't work hard!

CHELSEA CHEERLEADER & HUMBLE HANK: My favorite two personalities are Chelsea Cheerleader and Humble Hank. They are

cousins of Willy Nilly and related to Sara Sandbagger by marriage. Chelsea is the most positive person on the planet. The glass is always half full. She's like Sheryl Crow "not having what you want but wanting what you've got". She absolutely loves seeing her gal pals drag calves ahead of the cowboys and she cheers the loudest for her friends after they place higher than her at the show. Chelsea is a role model.

Then there is **Humble Hank**. Hank is the guy who doesn't say much but when he does, we all should listen. He is handy with his rope, good with his horse, and positive with all levels of abilities when branding. He is the Jedi Master, the hard working type, and the extra polite type. He rarely misses with his long string and almost always places in the show pen. Hank treats everyone with respect. He helps anyone who asks for it but is never critical. Hank is the man! The quiet confidence he exudes makes all ropers and show participants better by having been around him.





Fortunately I have had the opportunity to be around way more Hank's, Sara's, and Chelsea's than I have Pete's and Patty's. I hope the same is true for you! Until next time,
