








Trash Collection Policies & Procedures

Prior to disposal, **keep** bulk items, construction debris and yard waste **on your patio** until the **day before** pick up.

Inside the Enclosure	Outside the Enclosure	No Disposal	Dumpster - Clubhouse
<p>Trash</p> <p>USE HEAVY DUTY PLASTIC TRASH BAGS ONLY</p> <p>Properly bagged and tied trash bags ONLY inside of the wooden trash cart enclosures.</p>  <p>Deposit dog droppings into tied shut plastic bags and drop into trash cart.</p>  <p>Latex paint cans must be dried out and disposed of in a trash bag.</p>	<p>Bulk Items (Pickup on 2nd and 4th Monday) All bulk items are to be placed OUTSIDE of the wooden trash cart enclosures.</p> <p>Appliances & Furniture</p>  <p>Construction Debris</p>  <p>Carpet: Cut and tie into 4 ft. long rolls. Cut lumber to 4 feet lengths. All nails MUST be removed.</p> <p>Contractors are prohibited from disposing construction debris at Highland Lakes.</p> <p>Yard Waste/Apr.- Nov. (Dates on Herald Calendar)</p>  <p>Branches: Cut to 3' ft. lengths and tie in bundles. Leaves, weeds and potted plants etc in OUTDOOR PAPER trash bags only and left outside the wooden trash cart enclosures.</p>	<p>Hazardous Waste</p> <p>Hazardous waste items are NOT permitted to be disposed of on premises at anytime:</p> <p>Dry cell batteries Gasoline</p> <p>Paint thinner  Toxic Waste</p> <p>Oil Lead-acid Batteries</p> <p>Antifreeze</p> <p>Also-any other material with labels that read warning, danger, poison, caution or hazardous.</p> <p>E-waste (electronics, TVs, computers, cell phones)</p> <p>Look up https://search.earth911.com for further info.</p>	<p>Cardboard Boxes</p>  <p>Flatten cardboard and dispose of them in the recycle dumpster located in the clubhouse parking lot.</p>

TRASH COLLECTION AND PICKUP SCHEDULE

WHEN	WHAT	WHERE
GENERAL TRASH (including dog droppings)		
Anytime	Put general trash (incl. planter pots) into heavy duty large plastic trash bags Put dog droppings into plastic bags tied shut	Drop the trash bags and dog droppings in tied shut plastic bags into the trash carts inside the wooden trash carts enclosure
Mondays and Thursdays	Pick up by trash hauling company	From wooden trash carts enclosures
Prior to disposal, keep large bulk items, construction debris and yard waste in YOUR PATIO until the day before pickup		
LARGE BULK ITEMS* AND CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS**		
2nd and 4th Sundays	Put out large bulk items and resident's own construction debris	OUTSIDE Outside of wooden trash carts enclosures (visible to trash haulers)
2nd and 4th Mondays	Pick up of large bulk and residents' generated construction debris by trash hauling company	From outside of wooden trash carts enclosures (visible to trash haulers)
YARD WASTE (Leaves, plants, flowers etc.) * (April – November)		
Sundays (April – November)	Put out yard waste (incl. plants only- no pots) in outdoor paper trash bags .	OUTSIDE Outside of wooden trash carts enclosures (visible to yard waste haulers)
Mondays (April – November)	Pick up of yard waste in outdoor paper trash bags .	From outside of wooden trash carts enclosures (visible to yard waste haulers)
RECYCLING - LARGE CARDBOARD BOXES		
Anytime	Flatten Cardboard boxes – before deposit only	DUMPSTER - CLUBHOUSE Deposit in RECYCLE DUMPSTER at Clubhouse parking lot
HAZARDOUS MATERIAL *** (incl. OLD MEDICATION)		
Never	Hazardous material and electronic waste (TV, computers, etc.)	NO DISPOSAL AT HLCA NOT permitted for disposal on premises at any time
