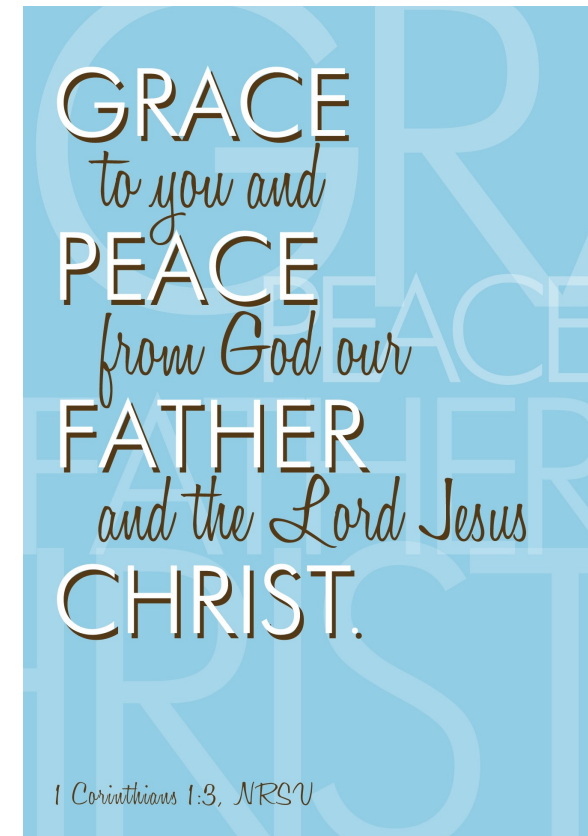

⇒ Need a devotion book? Take one and enjoy. There is a basket of books in the narthex.

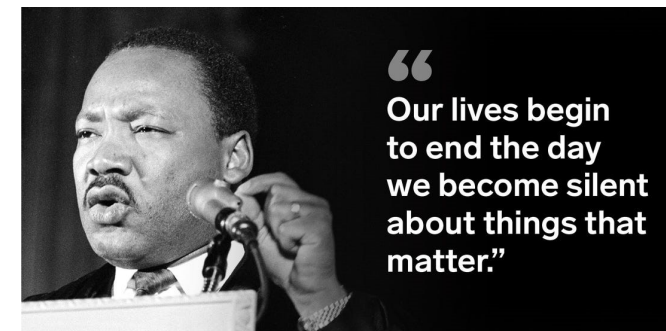
