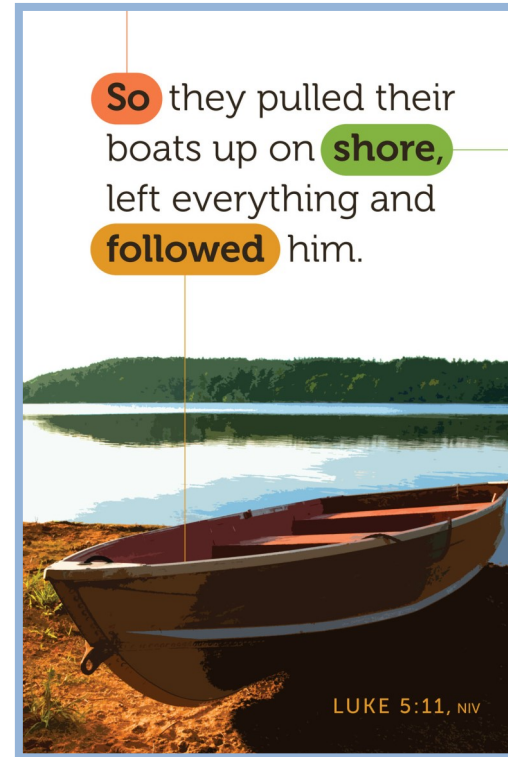

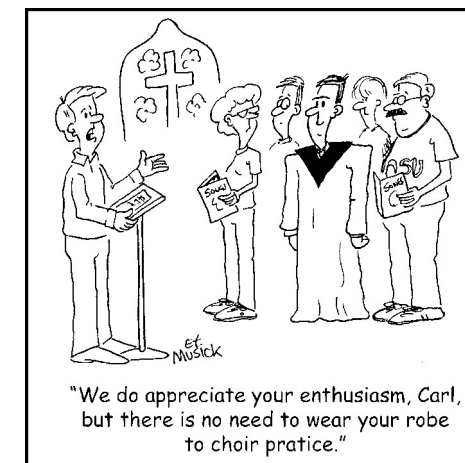


There will not be UMYF meetings tonight or next Sunday night (February 17). Sunday evening activities will resume on February 24.
