Ken's Bible Study resumes with Part 2 of "Do Good" on Wednesday, October 30.

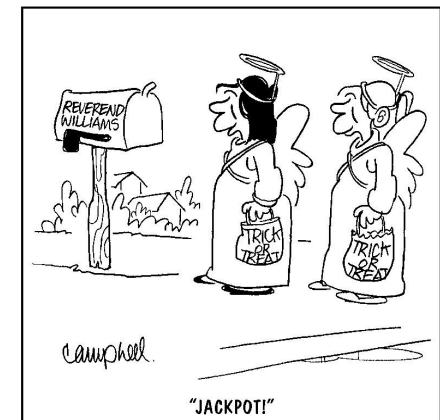

United Methodist Student Day is November 24

Do you remember the "good news" story from the Morehouse College commencement in May? The commencement speaker, billionaire Robert F. Smith, pledged that his family would pay off the \$40 million student loans of all 396 graduating seniors.

Wouldn't it be amazing if we were able to do something like that? What would it look like if, as a church family, we could help students graduate from college without the burden of overwhelming debt? On November 24, United Methodist Student Day, we have the opportunity to do exactly that.

United Methodist Student Day is one of six Special Sundays when we receive an offering for a particular ministry through the denomination.
