- **Organ Repair** EFUMC’s organ is in need of substantial repairs and a contract has been signed with Parkey Organ Builders for those repairs. The repairs will cost \$34,465.00. Several generous special gifts have been received and they will cover the ENTIRE cost of the repairs. In fact, the first \$10,000.00 of the cost has been paid and work is expected to be completed by October 31, 2026. The Organ Repair/Maintenance Fund that was established for this project has a remaining balance of \$ 25,140.00 as of July 15, 2026. Thanks to those generous special gifts, repair of the organ will not impact the General Fund (our checking account) that supports day-to-day church operations.
