probably 100 kids that have been touched by Jesus through the faithful ministry of many, many extraordinary volunteers, without whom this ministry would be impossible.


Though the origin of the story is unclear, there is a statue of Jesus that was damaged and the hands were broken off. Rather than replace the hands, a plaque was placed on it saying, "I have no hands but yours."

Indeed, Jesus works through the mentors, the Whiz Kids crew leaders and station leaders; through the Prayer Angels and their coordinator; through the kitchen help, and through the school district that provides the snack. It's all a cooperative effort made possible by the Holy Spirit overflowing in us.

Tell Someone About Celebrate Recovery!

Celebrate Recovery is a Christcentered recovery program that helps people with their hurts, habits,

and hang-ups. Hurts, habits, and hang-ups include addictions to drugs and/or alcohol, pornography, and co-dependency (just to name a few). They also include victims of sex abuse (as children & adults), human trafficking, co-dependency, and online scammers.

In the past, we have been negatively labeled as "those people", meaning we're a bunch of drug addicts and alcoholics. In the past nine years, we have successfully changed that stereotype to "a recovery group that helps people overcome their hurts, habits, and hang-ups by bringing them closer to Jesus Christ.'

September is Recovery Month. The second Sunday offering will go to Celebrate Recovery of Riverside. CR of Riverside is a non-profit group that relies solely on offerings/gifts from weekly meeting attendees and the congregation at Community Church. We use these offerings/gifts for purchasing CR Bibles, celebration chips/coins, weekly meals & drinks, sponsoring Emmaus attendees, T-shirts for testimony givers, and training.

We all know someone who could benefit from coming to Celebrate Recovery and developing (or increasing) their relationship with Jesus Christ.

together, it is a great opportunity to invite visitors, and to hear about what God is doing in each local congregation. A "hope filled" topic or message is presented.



Grace is not behavior modification, it's learning to rest in His promised love. Discover how grace frees you from:



In this powerful six-week series, you will encounter God's grace like never before.


