PASTOR SPEAKS

Dear Parishioners,

The Lord is risen, Alleluia!

Christians all over the world rejoice because our Lord is risen. This is a joyful moment. The death and resurrection of Christ is not only historic but also a mystery. Mystery events and celebrations go beyond time and space. They maintain their originality. Thus, over two thousand years of Christ's death does not make it irrelevant to our time as some believe; its freshness is present to us this year as the past and will be forever.

So, we celebrate Easter. And this reminds us that our faith is not in vain. It is a feast of Jesus' victory over sin and death. Easter is a statement that death is not the end of the story. During this Easter, let us be convinced that despite all the suffering that we may encounter in our lives we will be given the crown of glory and share in the glory of our Lord. Let us remember that we are Easter people and Alleluia is our song.

Let us be channels of the Risen Jesus, bringing the peace of His resurrection to those with whom we live and work and worship with and to the world. Happy Easter!
