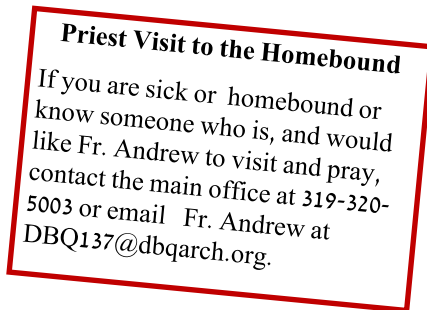

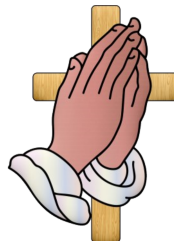

Dear Parishioners,



I want to introduce to you our 2024-2025 Liturgical Year parish theme and banner. It has been the practice over the last couple of years to come out with a theme to act as a guiding image for our individual and collective reflections as we journey through the year.

We typically get our banner ready and unveil it at the start of the Rosary month in October. We do that to ask for the maternal intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary for the parish and the families.

Our present theme is ***Pilgrims of Hope: We are Chosen, Faith-filled, and Joyful.*** It was considered to reflect the theme for the Jubilee Year 2025 to be celebrated by the Universal Church and the general parish vitality goal for the year. We will hear more about the Jubilee Year and the parish vitality goal later.

Pilgrims of Hope:

This inspiring phrase is the main theme for the Jubilee Year 2025 for the Universal Church, which starts at Advent. Pope Francis has indicated and launched the Jubilee Year to help us “fan the flame of hope that has been given us and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart, and far-sighted vision.”
