The Sacred Heart Sanctuary Guild met October 1, 2018 in the church library at 7:00 pm.

The Treasurer's Report: Checking Account \$11,395.13 and Saving Account \$5,100.05. \$7,000 will go into Sacred Heart's general fund and the remainder will go into the guild's checking account and savings account to be used as needed. This is an 80/20 split. A complete accounting of the report is attached to these minutes.

Old Business:

Archbishop Jackels was given \$100.00 and an assortment of kolaches for celebrating Mass with us. We had voted to give him \$200.00, but Fr said \$100.00 would be sufficient.

Doris reported on the first 20/20 Vision meeting.

More discussion was held on the council's request that perhaps the guild would be interested in purchasing a new heater for the water main/music room. First of all, they will have to get estimates of the cost. We had discussed what to do with the profit from the car show and perhaps that would be good use of that money. Another discussion was held in regard to the \$5,100 in savings (which had been ear marked for new doors).

New Business:

Discussion was held regarding transferring 1,500.00 into the savings account. Mary Ann 1st and Stacy 2nd to do so.

Stacy 1st and Mary Ann 2nd to change the wording of the savings account from "ear marked for church doors." The money (\$573.61) from the car show and the \$1,500.00 transferred into savings, and the \$5,100.05 already in savings may be used "as needed."

Mary Ann 1st and Stacy 2nd to purchase 4 units of plastic shelving to be used for the church dinner, as some of the shelving is in bad shape.

General discussion was held on ways to help the fall festival dinner run more smoothly. This will be revisited throughout the year.

It was felt that it would be a good idea for each of the chairpersons for the church dinner work on job descriptions for their particular area.
