


# Epiphany Proclamation 2019

In ancient times before calendars were common, about 325CE the Council of Nicaea established that **Easter** would be held on the first

Sunday after the first Full Moon occurring on or after the vernal equinox\*. From that point forward, **Easter** date depended on the ecclesiastical approximation of March 21 equinox.

While a day like Christmas is fixed in our mind, many of the important feasts of the Church year move, based upon the date that Easter is set. Easter changes each year moving to the Sunday after the "Paschal Full Moon," and can fall between March 22 & April 25. Interesting? Keep reading.



Dear brothers and sisters, the glory of the Lord has shone upon us, and shall ever be manifest among us, until the day of his return.

Through the rhythms of times and seasons let us celebrate the mysteries of salvation.

Let us recall the year's culmination,
the Easter Triduum of the Lord:
his last supper, his crucifixion, his burial,
and his rising celebrated
between the evening of the 18<sup>th</sup> of April
And the evening of the 20th of April,
Easter Sunday being on the 21st day of April.

Each Easter -- as on each Sunday -the Holy Church makes present
the great and saving deed
by which Christ has forever
conquered sin and death.
From Easter are reckoned
all the days we keep holy.

Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent, will occur on the 6th day of March.

The Ascension of the Lord will be commemorated on Sunday, the 2nd day of June or Thursday, the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May.

Pentecost, joyful conclusion of the season of Easter, will be celebrated on the 9th day of June.

And, this year the 1st Sunday of Advent will be on the 1st day of December 2019.

Likewise the pilgrim Church proclaims
the Passover of Christ
in the feasts of the holy Mother of God,
in the feasts of the Apostles and Saints,
and in the commemoration
of the faithful departed.

To Jesus Christ, who was, who is, and who is to come, Lord of time and history, be endless praise, forever and ever.

\*An equinox is the moment in time (not a day-long event) when the Sun stands directly above the equator day and night are of approximately equal length.


