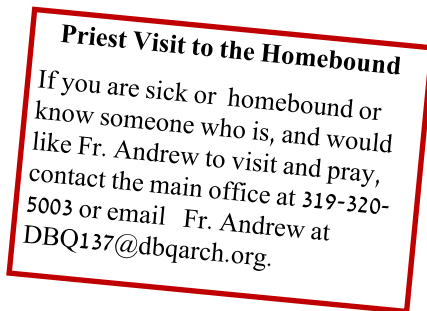

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, I want to share two significant issues and ideas from the USCCB. The first concerns the Feast of Christ the King, and the second concerns a new national initiative, Walk *With One*.

1. Christ the King Resources—November 24, 2024

The Committee for Religious Liberty has identified the Solemnity of Christ the King as a fitting moment in the liturgical year to promote the Church's teaching on religious freedom. They have prepared materials to help educate the faithful about this solemnity, which the Church celebrates this year on November 24, 2024.

Among the important points to note is a Novena to Christ the King, November 15–23, the nine days preceding the solemnity. The USCCB encourages Catholics to participate in this Novena. Let us take this time to offer prayers to our sovereign king for the freedom of the Church. Daily intentions and a concluding prayer to Christ the King can be found at www.usccb.org/Christ-the-King-2024-novena.

2. According to the National Eucharistic Revival

Secretariat, after the National Eucharistic Congress, we entered into the most important phase of our three-year National Eucharistic Revival: the Year of Mission. Catholics from all walks of life are encouraged to go out into the world and live a life of mission rooted in the Eucharist. The new keystone initiative for this year is *Walk With One*.

The Stages of Spiritual Companionship

1. Identify —through prayer choose someone God wants you to accompany on their journey home to the Church.
2. Intercede —Pray for them and ask God to remove whatever obstacles are making it difficult for this person to draw closer to Christ and his Church. Pray for the grace to be able to accompany them well.
3. Connect—Find ways to build a deeper relationship with this person.
4. Invite —Follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit. When the time is right, invite your friend to take a concrete next step in fostering a personal relationship with Jesus and the Church. This might mean joining you for a small group or Mass on Sunday.
