PASTOR SPEAKS

Pentecost: The Fulfillmant of God's Promise

Friends,

This weekend, we celebrate one of the greatest moments and feasts we have in the Church, and that is the feast of Pentecost. On this day, we not only recall but celebrate to receive again that transcendent and unique *Gift* of love specially sent to us from God the Father and the Son.

From the first moment the Holy Spirit was sent to the apostles and other members of the community of Jesus, there formed and came into being this powerful reality of "ecclesia magna," (great Church) where God gathers all His collectively as the members of His household.

Friends, this magnificent Gift of God, the Holy Spirit, is so powerfully present to us as believers and remains everything we can conceive Him to be in the superlative form. I mean consider the day He came upon the apostles; we read that the sheer magnitude of His power was heard loudly all over the upper room where the apostles were gathered.

The Holy Spirit is the dynamic love that connects the Father and the Son, and He is issued from the two of them as they are of equal substance. He is the breath that the Father and the Son exchange and breathe into us.

Before His ascension, Jesus, as recorded in Acts of the Apostles Chapter 1: 1-11, instructed His apostles to remain in Jerusalem and wait for the promise of the Father (Cf Lk 24: 49). Then from the First Reading of Pentecost Sunday, also taken from Acts Chapter 2: 1-11, we learn how the apostles obediently stayed in Jerusalem and received the Holy Spirit. These readings point us to an important part of the Pentecost experience—obedience to God's commandment leads to fulfillment of God's promises.

Indeed, Abraham's obedience led to the fulfillment of God's promise of a great posterity and land for his descendants. Moses' obedience led to the experience of the promised land for the Israelites. Obedience is the only powerful expression of our love for God and the trust in His wisdom and goodness. In obedience, we show our desire to walk in His ways, and this is the key to unlocking His blessings in our lives.

Well, during this great feast of Pentecost, let us learn from the apostles' obedience and God's fidelity to make happen what He has promised. When we choose to obey God, we become aligned with His will and open ourselves to the fulfillment of his promises.
