PASTOR SPEAKS 2025 Lenten and Parish Mission

Dear Parishioners,

As we race towards the end of winter, we anticipate some warm days soon. That sounds exciting, doesn't it? Honestly, I am prepared to skip spring and get to summer. But while we wait for our favorite seasons to arrive, I would like to draw your attention to another season that is starting in two weeks— for this one is a spiritual season and good for our souls— Lent.

Following Ash Wednesday, March 5, the traditional Lenten spiritual activities such as Stations of the Cross during the weekdays, reconciliation opportunities, adorations, and talks will begin. More details will be provided on parish websites, other social media platforms, and in bulletins.

However, on this occasion, I would like to address myself to the Parish Mission that will take place on March 9 & 10. It is meant for all our three-sister, linked parishes of St. John, St. Isidore, and Sacred Heart. And I would like to personally invite all of you to consider attending it.

What then is a parish mission?

Parish missions can be understood as a retreat for the parishioners to renew themselves and the parish. While parish missions can take several forms, often speaker (s) are invited to the parish to lead the missions with a series of talks on themes related to the Catholic faith to inspire and challenge the parishioners to sustain their individual and collective faith. A parish mission can take a day or two or even more.

You might have already heard through earlier announcements about this year's theme, *"Recharging your Spiritual Battery."* It was chosen by the speaker upon my recommendation.

In addition, regarding the timing for the Mission, you may recall that the last mission we had two years ago also took place in the first week of Lent just like this one. I think that starting the Lenten Season with a parish mission puts us in the spirit of Lent and gets us to start thinking deeply about the season and the spiritual expectations.

Also, you may remember that at the last mission, there was a one topic presentation and the content for the two days was the same. Therefore, it was suggested that one could attend one of the two days and receive the same information. However, while the topic of this year's presentation is the same for the two nights, the content is different each day. Therefore, to miss one night means missing one half of the presentation. So, I strongly urge everyone to plan to make the two-day mission. But if your schedule does not permit it, make at least one.
