Disciple Maker Index (DMI) survey

Dear Parishioners.

Our Sacred Heart Parish Community is constantly on a journey, a pilgrimage we undertake with full hope to know, love, and serve Jesus in our lifetime. Together, we must embrace Christ's vision for missionary discipleship so our parish can thrive and be a place for others to grow together in faith.

Many of us participated in the archdiocesan survey for the global synod in what became known in the Dubuque Archdiocese as Parish Vitality during January and February of 2022. Archbishop Zinkula has reviewed the synod report generated by 16,000 household responses. The **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** survey is the next step in a process that will lead to new mission and vision statements, and pastoral priorities.
