2. Fr. James Gigliotti, TOR Pastor of St. Andrew Church, Forth Worth, TX.

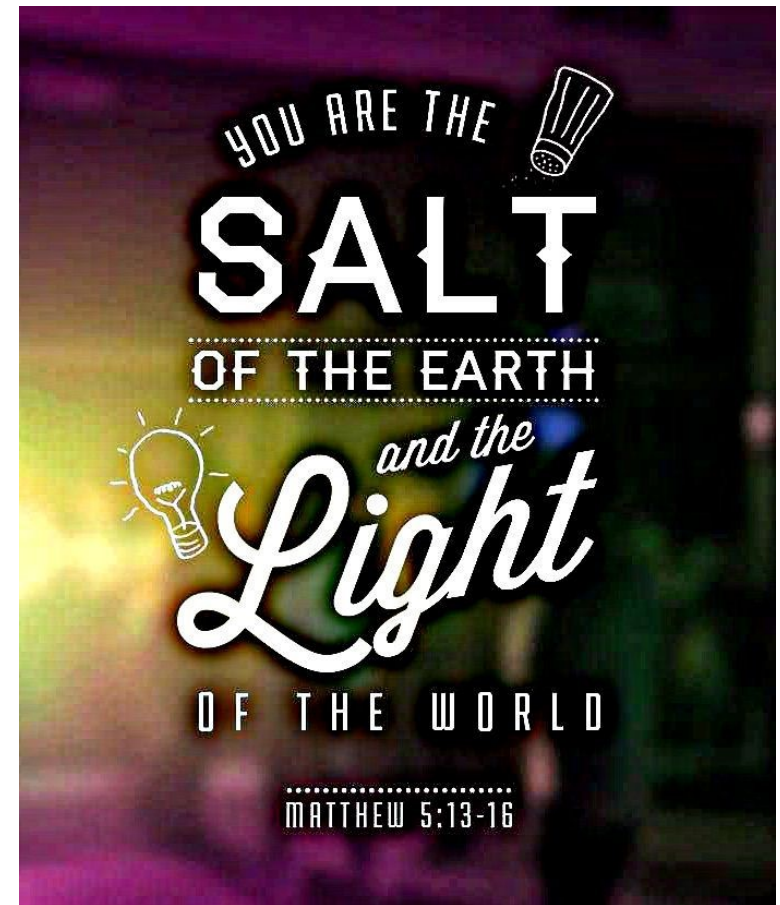
