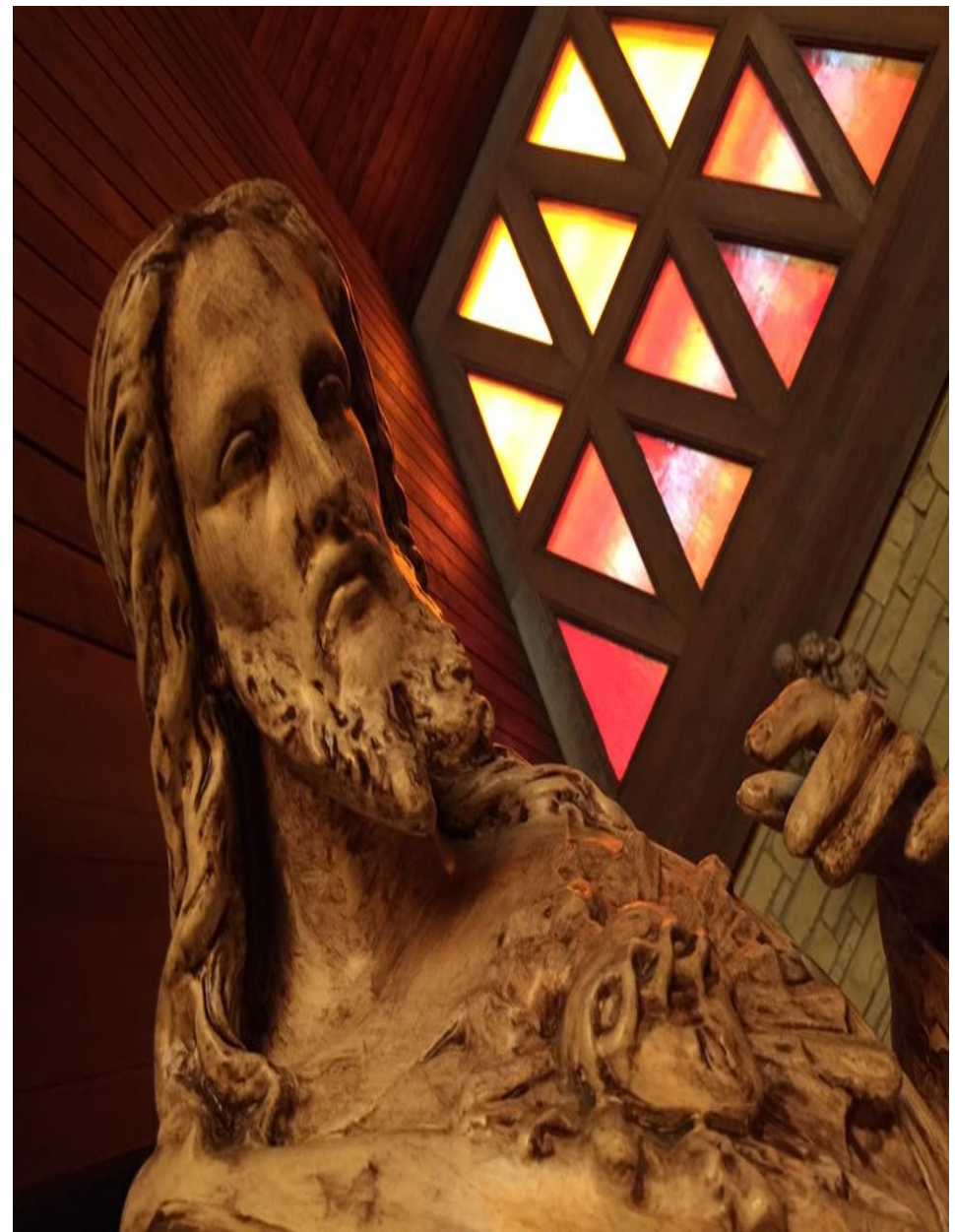

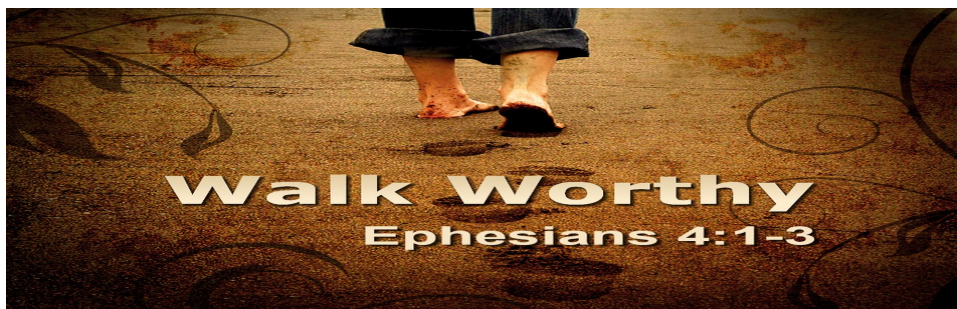

Why do Catholics light candles?



The light signifies our prayer offered in faith coming into the light of God. Adapted from ancient Judaism, 1st century Catholics lit candles for Mass, prayer ceremonies and at the tombs of martyrs to show reverence to the Blessed Sacrament. Catholics often light a candle before a statue or sacred image of our Lord or of a saint.
