#### UNDERSTANDING PARISH LIFE AND STRUCTURE

One breathtaking genius of the Catholic Church is that it is highly structured; the bits and pieces of church life are intended to connect and function to sustain it. From the universal church to the parish level, some structures are aligned with a good church life to support its proper functioning in a multitude of ways. The Parish Council, Finance Council, the paid and volunteered staff, committees, and groups are connected for a healthy parish.

In the next couple of weeks, I will be sharing my thoughts and expectation concerning some of these organizational structures and their responsibilities in our Sacred Heart parish life. Therefore, please make use of the weekly bulletin and pick some for those who miss Mass, so they don't miss the vision and expectations we are requiring from all of us.

Remember that we are the people of the Catholic community of Sacred Heart Church, a parish of the Archdiocese of Dubuque, who gather as a Eucharist-centered community. And by virtue of our baptism, we're all obligated to worship, share the word of God, and live our lives in holiness. We are called to lifelong faith formation and attending Weekend Mass is an obligation and an integral part of faith formation.

#### The Parish Council, Nature and Purpose.

The Parish Council generally offers counsel to and collaborates with the pastor to provide the long-range planning which will guide the parish toward its future. Its Purpose includes:

- A. To work with the pastor to facilitate a process by which the mission of the parish is determined and to serve as stewards of that mission.
- B. To help implement the mission through pastoral planning, which includes assessing the parish needs, identifying resources, determining priorities.
- C. To collaborate with the Finance Council, the staff, and other committees and groups to maintain appropriate stewardship of treasure, time, and talents that support a thriving parish.
- D. To ensure that any parish-affiliated individuals or groups abide by the rules of the Archdiocese of Dubuque and the Parish Council, the Faith Formation Commission, and committees or groups.
- E. To ensure that all activities in the parish have the approval of the pastor or the Parish Council.
