It's with much excitement and delight that I convey to you, greetings from home, especially from my mother and siblings. They know I brought you with me. Each one of you, my parishioners! They see you on my face, in my heart, thoughts, and words. They have learned how much you love me; how you care for me! I extended to them your warm felicitations and sentiments of love and sympathies. Everyone is delighted to see me; indeed, they've all missed me a lot ... as I have missed them! They've understood clearly why I always tell them "I'm doing fabulously well" whenever they ask about how life is treating me in the U.S.

Therefore, I gratefully acknowledge the events, circumstances, and the people that worked together to make my visit possible. I deeply appreciate the ministerial support extended to the parishes by Fr. Juhl and the parish staff and leadership of St. John, St. Isidore, and Sacred Heart.

At the moment, I'm staying at St. Theresa's Minor Seminary where I received my high school education. After my ordination, this was the only place I lived and served as a formator and teacher of young men who were answering the call to the priesthood until I came to the U.S. Incidentally, the Seminary is excitedly preparing to mark its 90 years of existence.

We're talking about years of incredible formation for a multitude of poor and promising young boys who keep passing through its gates to become priests or successful individuals in Ghana.
