

The Table of the Lord

Back when many of us were growing up, mealtime had a special significance. It was a time to gather around the table to share the news of our day...and some good food! Gathering as a family around the dinner table to share a meal was not only tradition, it was almost sacred. We wouldn't have the TV on or take a phone call. Gathering together as a family was important, an occasion to be together with our family every day. The same is true of the importance of gathering around the table of the Eucharist at Mass, a very special time to come together as a "faith family" to share something truly extraordinary...food from heaven!

As Catholics, we believe the Eucharist is not a representation, not a symbol of Christ, but it *is* Christ. That is why the Church sets aside a day every year to celebrate the Eucharist, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), which we celebrate this weekend, focusing on the very essence of our faith. Holy Communion is a source of strength to us, food for our journey through this life to the next. The Catholic Church is more than 2,000 years old, and in the Church everything comes and goes, like people and popes, but the one constant throughout the ages, has been the Eucharist, the very presence of Christ.


When Jesus ascended into heaven, he knew he had to go, but he also knew he had to stay, so he left for us the gift of his body and blood, the Eucharist. He gave us the Eucharist to help us in our trials and

sufferings in this world, to nourish us. It helps us to realize that we are not alone. We are looked after. We are cared for. It is not just something we receive, but something that changes who we are. We cannot receive it and not be changed, becoming a new creation in Christ.

During Mass, when Father proclaims the words "This is my body and this is my blood," the act of transubstantiation, when the bread and wine become the body and blood of Christ, it is the most important moment of the Mass. By these words of consecration, the bread and wine are no longer bread and wine, but Christ himself, and, when we receive the Holy Eucharist, Christ Himself enters our hearts, fills our veins and, literally, transforms our souls. He becomes a part of us, and we become a part of him.

The Eucharist must always be the center of our lives; we cannot live without it. Sadly, many of us have lost the precious family time around the dinner table. We have let the "busyness" of our lives get in the way. We must strive to return to that sacred time of gathering our families around the dinner table at home AND around the altar at church. We all need to be at the table...especially at the table of the Lord!
