Archbishop Zinkula's Pallium Mass:

A couple of weeks ago, I wrote to inform you about an upcoming archdiocesan celebration for Archbishop Tom Zinkula. As a form of reminder and encouragement to those who would wish to witness it, I decided to repeat what I wrote about it earlier. This way, those who might not have paid attention to it or were not around to learn about it earlier become privy to it respond.

To that end, the Archdiocese of Dubuque is inviting all the faithful of the archdiocese to join in the celebration of Holy Mass at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, Hiawatha in honor of Archbishop Zinkula upon receiving his Pallium from Pope Francis on September 8, 2024.

Below are the details provided by the archdiocese. Mass, with the Imposition of the Sacred Pallium on Archbishop Zinkula by His Eminence Christopher Cardinal Pierre, Apostolic Nuncio to the United States, is at 2:00 p.m. Archbishop Zinkula will preside, and Cardinal Pierre will give a talk before the Mass from 1:15 p.m. to 1:45 p.m. His Eminence will impose the Pallium on Archbishop Zinkula and deliver the homily.

Archbishop Zinkula received the Pallium from Pope Francis in Rome on June 29. This Mass allows us to collectively celebrate and focus on unity when the Papal Nuncio imposes the Pallium on him. The Mass will be livestreamed for those unable to attend.

What is pallium? The Encyclopedia Britannica describes a pallium as a "liturgical vestment worn over the chasuble by the pope, archbishops, and some bishops in the Roman Catholic Church. It is bestowed by the pope on archbishops and bishops having metropolitan jurisdiction as a symbol of their participation in papal authority."

As the definition indicates, not all bishops receive and wear a Pallium but only those with metropolitan jurisdiction. Thus, given the four arch/dioceses that constitute the Church in Iowa, the Archdiocese of Dubuque, being the first among the four, is the metropolitan head. Hence, whoever is the Archbishop of Dubuque also becomes the Metropolitan Archbishop.

It was voted on by the Ladies of the Sacred Heart and approved by the Parish Council to share a "Table of Plenty" beginning the first Sunday of October and continuing on the first Sunday of each month. The idea is to have parishioners bring a homemade item to sell to parishioners with the proceeds going to Sacred Heart church. You would price the item yourself, think about the supplies you need to make your item plus your time, and remembering that this is a fund raising project. Examples of the items for October could: bags of apples, tomatoes, potatoes, onions, squash, pumpkins, a dozen eggs, a dozen cookies, cake, loaf of bread, cinnamon rolls, any kind of baked goods, canned goods etc.... The details are still being worked out. We are excited to try this idea, and hopefully, our whole church family will become involved as the time goes by. More to come!
