Make October a Jubilee of the Rosary Novena

Dear Friends.

A few weeks ago, I left Iowa for Ghana to see my family. I am grateful for the time and opportunity to connect with my mom, siblings, and friends. There were exciting moments and sad stories—some loved ones have passed, and others are not doing well physically.

What strikes me is that, as much as I enjoyed the visit and even wished to stay longer, I am now back in Iowa, and those feelings are behind me. The visit is over, and what remains is nostalgia. Jesus told us in Mark 13:31, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away." Everything in life comes and goes quickly, no matter how much we desire it to remain. Only God's word and prayer endure with constancy.

God is waiting to answer your prayers. One clear path is the rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, especially during October. Make this October a Jubilee of the rosary for you and your family.

Life teaches us that the things we worry about most are usually the things most important to us. What is not important rarely causes anxiety. The Bible invites us to persistent prayer to show how deeply we value what we ask for. The rosary, by its nature, is patterned on persistence. Through repetition of the Lord's Prayer and the Hail Mary, we demonstrate perseverance before God, and the intentions we present become priorities in our lives.

Praying the rosary should not be viewed as a mere routine of words. Instead, it is a prayer that calls for persistence, engaging all our faculties and aligning us spiritually, mentally, and physically with God. In this way, persistence becomes a form of trust, shaping our priorities and strengthening our faith.

This October, take the things that weigh most heavily on your heart and turn them into intentions for the rosary. Each year, the Church dedicates October to the rosary. Make this one a Jubilee, a month-long novena of prayer, so that through repetition, reflection, and faith, you and your family may find strength and peace in God's presence.
