### **T56 Reverse Lockout Timer Installation Guide**

For the Tremec T56 reverse lockout solenoid, use the following connector: GM # 12101857 or ACDelco # PT249. This connector is not included. You will also need a momentary-closed pushbutton switch, mounted where you will find it convenient. I mounted mine on the left side of the shifter bezel. You can see the switch mounting details on this page:



There are four wires coming out of the timer:

- -Black Wire Ground wire
- -Blue Wire Timer trigger wire
- -White Wire Timed 12V for the lockout solenoid.
- -Red Wire Power for the timer circuit
- Step 1. Connect the Black Wire to a good ground.
- Step 2. Connect the Blue Wire to your pushbutton switch. Connect the other terminal of the pushbutton switch to a good ground.
- Step 3. Connect the White Wire to one side of the reverse lockout solenoid connector. Connect the other side of the reverse lockout solenoid connector to a good ground. Hook up the connector to the reverse lockout solenoid.
- Step 4. Connect the Red Wire to a good +12 volt source. I used the lighter power from under the shifter bezel. It wouldn't hurt to add a 5A or 10A inline fuse.
