




- Be ready and prepared to learn

Possible Behavioral Consequences

- Behavior is tracked weekly and recorded for Responsibility & Accountability.
 - Formal and Informal Consequences In order...
- 1.Warning
- 2.Conference with myself and administration
 - Call home on speaker phone in front of me to explain to your parents what classroom problems we are having.
- 3.Formal parent/teacher conference appointment-
 - After school or lunch detention
- 4.Formal referral and write up (STEP) stays on permanent record.
 - Loss of classroom privileges, labs and projects which will affect your grade.
 - Could lead to suspension, placed in Independent Study program or withdrawn from BCHS.

Should be a fun safe place for you to learn!


Follow the rules, respect yourself, each other and we will have a great time!!!

If you're late to class.... it happens!

- If you are a couple of minutes late to class, come in quietly and find your seat immediately.
- If you are more than 8 minutes late to class and do not have a pass from the office, do not come directly to my class. You MUST have a pass from attendance first, then come to class. (excused or not) If coming from another class, you MUST have a pass from your previous teacher.
- If you are late, do not interrupt class and ask what you have missed, it is your responsibility to get that information after class.
- Excused tardies will be able to make up bell ringers, unexcused will not have that opportunity.

- All bell ringers will be stamped daily and your notebooks will be checked at least weekly.


During Instruction

- I can't help you if I didn't know you needed it! Embarrassed? Use my office hours, email...


I am here For YOU!!

- I will NOT try to figure out who it belongs to. I will hang it up and


you can check it out yourself. Remember every



Maintaining the classroom

- During labs, I will stop all projects 10-15 minutes before the bell rings in order to clean up.
- Everyone is responsible for cleaning up. If you choose not to participate, you will lose your lab privileges the following day or next lab. - No warning issued- immediate call home!
- Pick up any trash you see around your table, whether it belongs to you or not.
- Keep your tools organized and safe in the cabinet. Remember that you are responsible for the upkeep and safety of all items checked out to you.
- Do not intentionally deface school, personal or other property.
- Do not take anything that does not belong to you.
- There will be appropriate consequences should you take anyone's personal or school property. This includes borrowing someone else's tools.

Substitutes

- Due to the nature of my position at this school, I will be gone on many occasions for FFA functions. Therefore you will have several substitute teachers throughout the year.
- Remember that we treat guests in our room with respect and courtesy.
- Sit in your assigned seat only.
- Be quiet and respectful and stay on task.
- A formal report for each class is always submitted to administration and I receive a copy. This is for both good and bad actions.
- Remember that even though I am gone, consequences will still be applied FOR GOOD AND BAD BEHAVIOR.

Dismissal

- This is a reminder that I will let you know when you may pack up to leave.
- Regardless of what the clock says, I will dismiss you when it's time to go.
