Registrations are complete and it is time to get things in order to get the participants on the ball field. In this letter I will update you on how we plan to proceed with information and dates. We are running a little behind the original plan. One reason is because the Amherst organization will not have a Fall Ball program this year because they lease their fields from the Amherst County School system, and they will not be allowed to use the fields during the pandemic. Now MHYBA is facing an increase of players and teams. This takes more time to get everyone registered, players placed on teams and an effort to find more coaches and team sponsors. Below I will list our plans for the upcoming season. Please understand these plans could change suddenly. We are hoping the number of Covid-19 cases will decline so the Governor will not place the State back into Phase II. All we can do is plan for today and make any changes should they become necessary.

1. MHYBA will hold its managers meeting Monday, 8/3/20 at 6:30pm at the Madison Heights Community Center. This meeting is to prepare the managers for the upcoming season with information concerning the season plans for their team and guidelines that must be followed concerning Covid-19
2. You should hear from your team manager by Wednesday, August 5th
3. Practices will begin the week of August 10th
4. Practice schedules will be posted on the website no later than August 6th
5. Games will start the week of August 24th
6. Game schedules will be posted on the website no later than August 19th
7. Games will continue thru the week of October 5th

MHYBA understands that we are pushing the schedule into a small window of time but with all the circumstances that we face to prepare for a successful season this is what we must do.
