On June 1, 2013, a dear friend and animal advocate, Bill Watson, passed away at his home in Traverse City, MI. We met Bill & Lynne Watson in 2003 when they needed to find a home for two pot-bellied pigs (Porgy & Bess) and two Scottish Highland steers (Sir Patrick & Sir Edward). Bill's health issues forced the couple to minimize responsibilities at their Stone Pony Ridge Animal Rescue. Both

were active in fostering and coordinating adoptions for unwanted or abandoned animals in the northwestern Michigan area and instrumental in rescue efforts after Hurricane Katrina. For the past ten years, Bill & Lynne have coordinated fundraising events for Black Sheep Crossing Farm Animal Sanctuary.

Bill requested that memorial donations be directed to his church and/or to Black Sheep Crossing. Bill has gone to the Rainbow Bridge to join those animals who have been waiting for him there. Lynne plans to continue fundraising efforts for Black Sheep Crossing while caring for horses, dogs, and a cat at Stone Pony Ridge.
