KEEP YOUR MICROPHONE ON MUTE

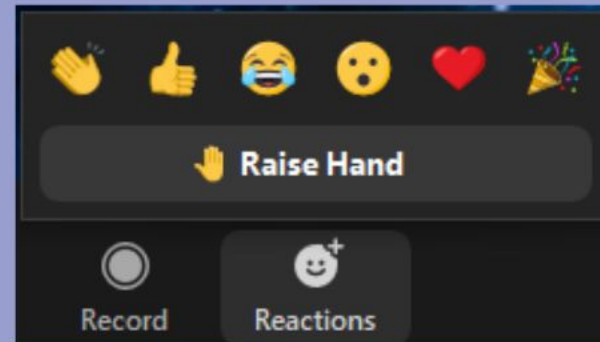
If you want to say something, raise your hand and wait for a volunteer to acknowledge you before unmuting.

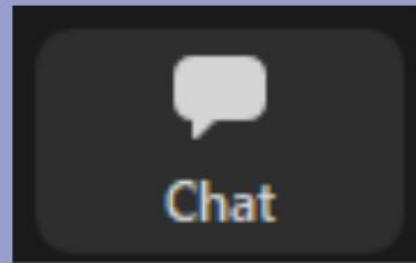
REACTIONS - RAISE YOUR HAND

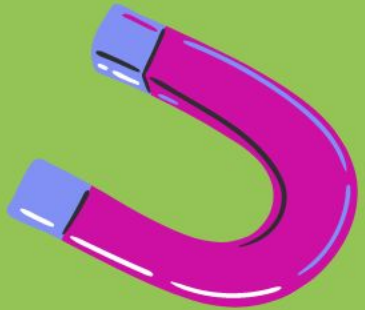
