

**RESOLUTION NO. 101**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE WISE COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE SUPPORTING LEGISLATION TO CREATE THE WISE REGIONAL WATER DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Wise County is experiencing rapid population growth, which is expected to continue for many years;

WHEREAS, the Wise County Mayors Coalition Steering Committee (WCMCSC) has been formed to address the growing water, wastewater, and waste needs of Wise County’s citizens;

WHEREAS, the WCMCSC has requested that state legislators representing Wise County introduce and support legislation to create a regional water district during the Regular Session of the 89th Texas Legislature;

WHEREAS, the Wise County Chamber of Commerce recognizes the importance of establishing a regional water district to manage water, wastewater, and waste services for the benefit of Wise County residents and businesses;

WHEREAS, the Wise County Chamber of Commerce recognizes that a reliable water infrastructure is critical not only for residents but also for local businesses.
