RIGIN

It's the year 2097, and Earth has almost melted due to the Millennials and Boomers. Mars has been colonized since the late '40s, and Uranus followed three decades later with the assistance of Safety Dome Living. Mars adults were sent there to breed pure Uranians. They now have their first batch of teens from birth, who have been denied access to pop culture. Safety Dome Realty is now in need of a new Head of Sales and is seeking a diversity hire from Earth.

No Earth teenager has ever set foot on Uranus, until now.

PILOT SET UP

We open in Uranus, the year 2097: Uranus is colonized with the help of Safe Dome Reality, The CEO announces a diversity hire, Waylon Johnson from Earth, who has a family including a teenager. The team is skeptical. Uranus has never had an earth teen before as they are considered sinister,

Meanwhile back on Earth, which has almost melted. Meet Blaze Johnson, a rebellious Queen Bee teen at West Antarctica High. She's about to start her senior year when Stepdad Waylon announces they're moving to Uranus, along with her nerdy sister, mom, and baby sister. They swing by the nursing home to farewell kooky dementia ridden Gen Z Grandpa Jayden who is still stuck in the early 20s – the Nurse insists they take him.

When they arrive in Uranus, things are off. Sure it has multiple moons, and diamond rain, but the teens are like trained foot soldiers and suddenly Queen Bee Blaze is the misfit and Ophelia is top rank. 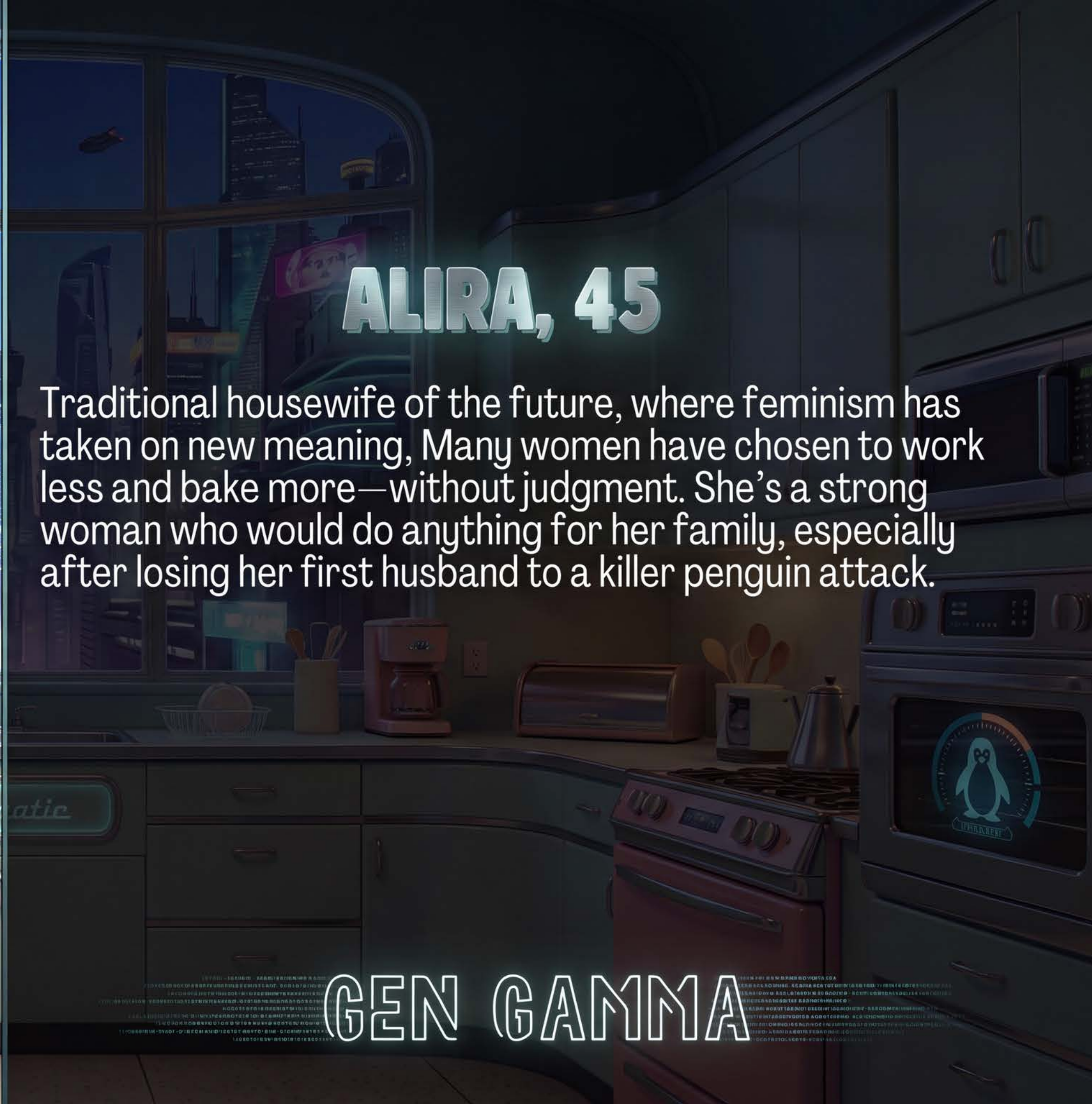
GEN EPSILON

A long, quirky flight across the system.



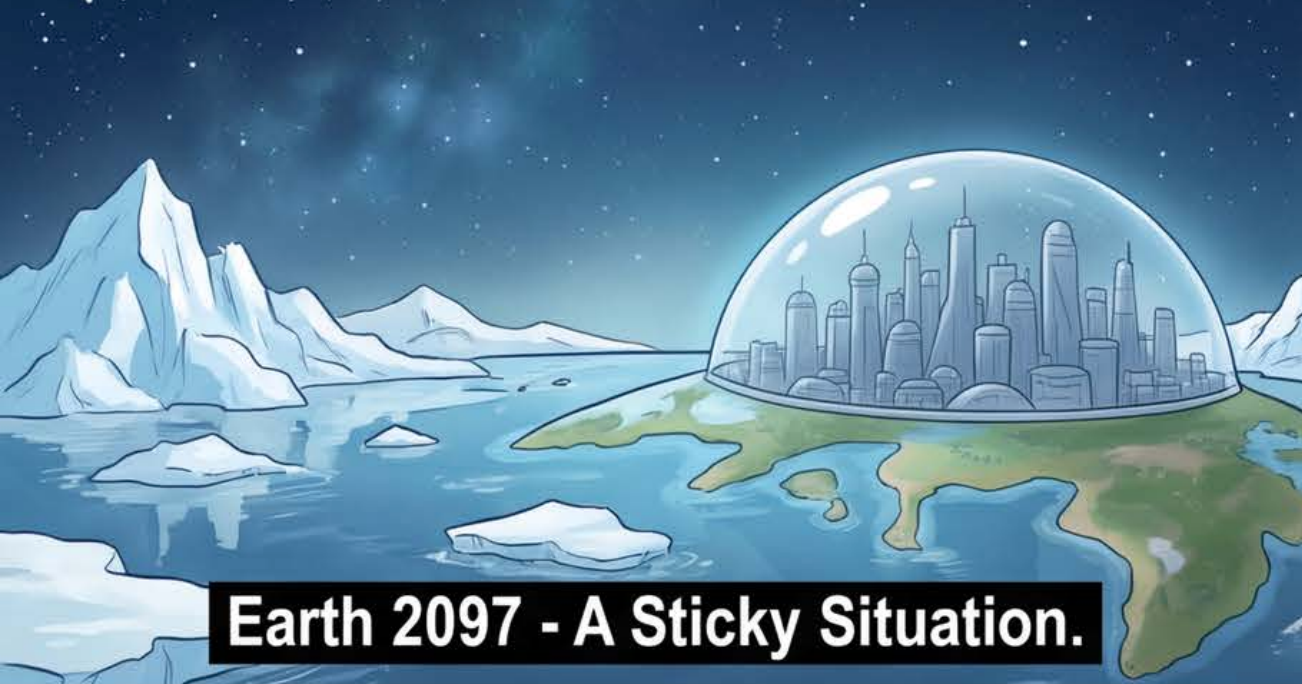

EPISODE IDEAS

Episode: "Pray to God Uranus"

In an attempt at damage control, the Johnsons turn to religion and join the local church, where they worship Uranus, the Greek god of the sky. Alira gets swept up in the cult-like atmosphere, while Blaze and Zafria continue to butt heads in their love triangle.

Episode: "Diamond Lockdown"

A diamond storm traps the family inside for a week, forcing Alira to home-school the girls whilst Grandpa Jayden experiences PTSD from the 2020 lockdown.

Episode: "Public Hole-iday"

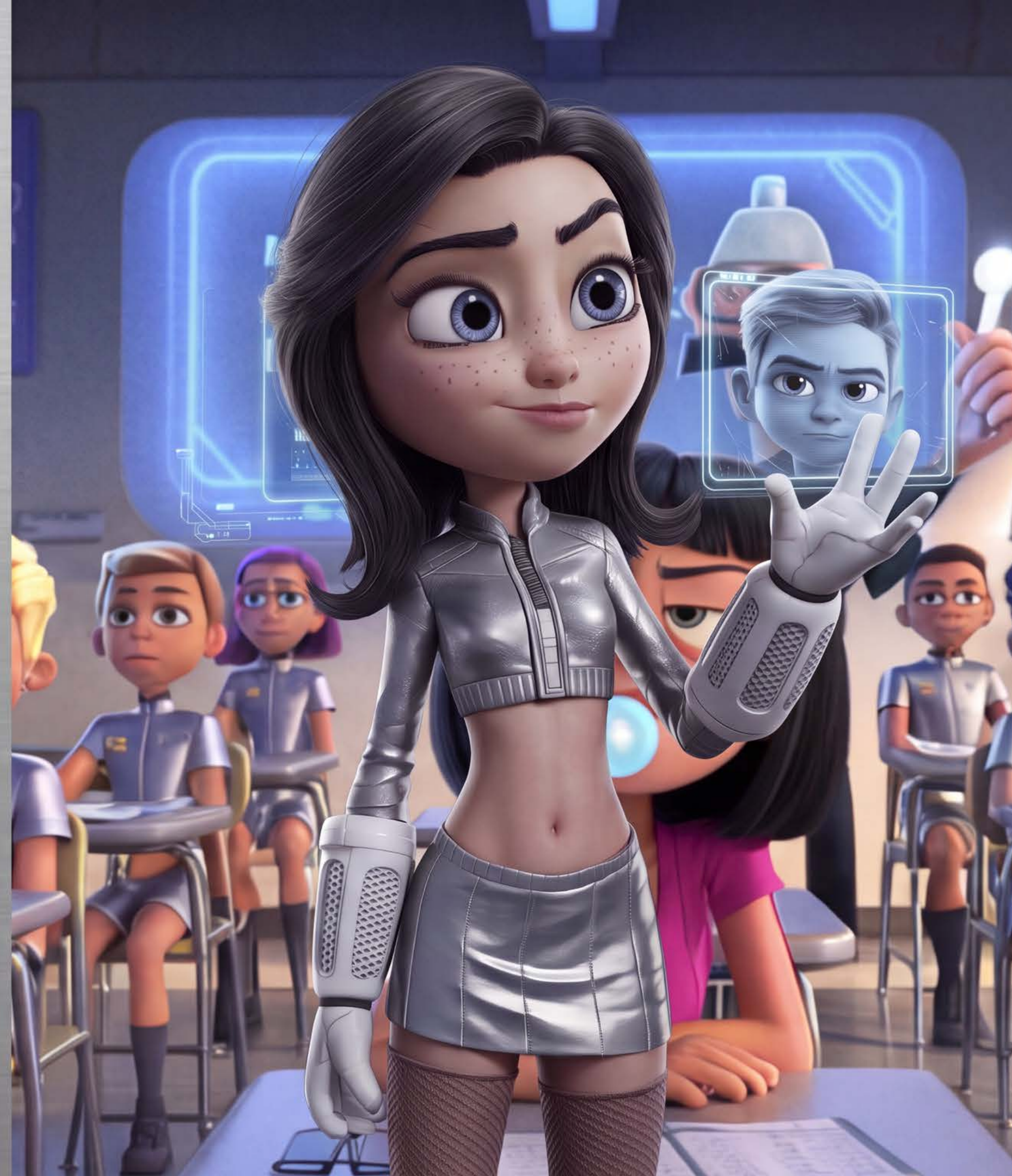
Celebrating Uranus's colonization, the family expects a day off, but instead, it's a 17-hour work/school day that the Uranians eagerly anticipate. Blaze struggles to maintain her interplanetary relationship with Cypher, but she manages to make up with Zafria.

Episode: "You're Going to Be Popular"

Waylon takes Alira on a weekend getaway to Moon Titania, leaving Grandpa Jayden in charge (big mistake). Blaze throws a nerd party at their dome with science and math trivia. Ophelia helps Blaze cheat, which unexpectedly brings the sisters closer together.

Episode: "Frozen Lake of Methane"

Blaze takes on a weekend job at a local skating rink to earn some diamonds. She finds herself caught in a flirtation with a mysterious, half-alien skater from Titus.



EPISODE IDEAS

Episode: “Uranus Has Got Talent”

At the school talent show, Zafria and Blaze perform a song that spreads more pop culture corruption of the teens. Ophelia wins by reciting the periodic table of Uranus. Meanwhile, Grandpa Jayden steals the family shuttle and gets hopelessly lost in a Uranian windstorm.

Episode: “The Uranian Dating Game”

Blaze surprise holograms into her prom and catches Cypher cheating on her with her best friend back, sending her to go on the rebound in Uranus. Meanwhile, Alira begins to suspect that Waylon is having an affair with Svea, the attractive robot assistant at his office.

Episode: “21 Years of Winter”

Blaze experiences intense sickness as Alira worries that she’s pregnant, but it turns out to be just Uranus is flipping in 21 years of dark Winter. Meanwhile, Grandpa Jayden turns 33 (age updated from original text), and the family throws him a 2015-themed party, celebrating the year he was born.

Episode: “World’s Colliding”

A replacement shuttle from Earth finally arrives, only for the family to discover that Earth, as they knew it, is gone. The shuttle is filled with Earth survivors, including Blaze’s ex-boyfriend Cypher, who is now dating her best friend.
