This triangular shaped tree is one you'll find very versatile as it can be left out long after the holidays. A joyful snowman sports a colorful plaid scarf and top hat. And a multi-colored background sets off the white holly leaves & snowflakes that frame the snowman. When the weather is frightful outside, this little guy will be quite comfortable inside by your fireplace or wherever you choose to put him.



## One for the Carpenter! Created by Diane & Dan Yoder

You won't believe it, but two rusty repurposed hand saws welded together make this unique tree! The silver star that sits atop the tree is cut from diamond plate. Plus, a silver chain forms the garland that drapes from side to side. This one-of-a-kind tree is sure to be a conversation piece in your holiday decorations. Any way you slice it... this would be a great tree for the handyman (or woman) in your life.



# From a Country Garden Designed & Created by Lida Hood

This tree is made from chalk painted pallet boards to represent the rustic look of nature. Ornaments include watercolor painted seed packets, peat pot bells, plus a small dried herb wreath. Sitting atop the tree is a rustic star made from natural materials like milkweed pods and dried cornhusks. Seed packets are filled with seeds from Lida's own country garden. A painted clay pot sits under the tree, giving it a festive feel. A real gardener's delight!



# Oh, Holy Night Painted by Jen Fultz

This two-sided farmhouse tree can be up all winter long! One side has a nativity scene with O Holy Night in starlight above the creche. The other side has the word SNOW falling down the center. Both sides are textured with a navy paint washed over it.



# **A Very "Mosaic" Christmas**Designed & Created by Terry Walters

One of our stained glass instructors, Terry, has outdone herself with this fantastic tree! It's made entirely from hundreds of tiny glass pieces. A bouquet of holly adorns the center of the tree, and colorful "faux" Christmas lights are incorporated into the design. White glass adds a snowy touch to the tree's boughs. Making this tree complete is a 3-D snowflake that adorns the top.
